I WILL OFFER TO THEE THE SACRIFICE OF THANSGIVING (PSA. 116:17)

THE two words that should always be on the tip of our mind's tongue are "Thank God." Not just "God", but "THANK God." From the Kitchen of Aunt ~~Jan~~ to Grandma Johnson, to Aunt Ginny

Jewish Apple Cake

Ingredients

- 1 cup oil
 - 2 cups sugar
 - 4 eggs
 - 3 cups sifted flour
 - 3 tsp baking powder
 - 1/2 tsp salt
 - 1/2 cup orange juice
 - 1 tbsp vanilla (scant)
 - 4 large apples peeled and sliced
- Sugar Mix:
- 4 tbsp sugar
 - 2 tsp cinnamon

Directions

1. Grease 10" tube pan with margarine and flour. Pare and slice apples, and set aside.
2. Beat eggs, add in sugar, gradually add oil.
3. Sift dry ingredients and add alternately with orange juice. Add vanilla.
4. Put 1/4 of the mix into the pan and 1/3 of the apples. Sprinkle with 1/3 of sugar mix.
5. Repeat layers, end with butter on top.
6. Bake at 350 for 80 minutes.
