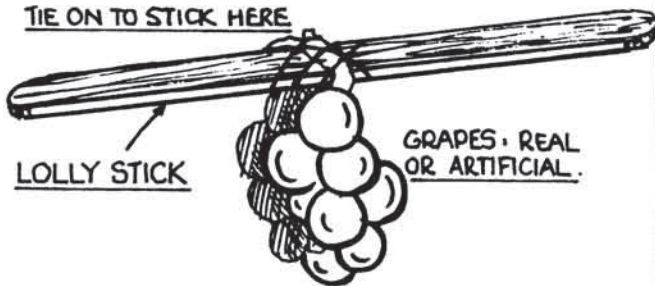


Twelve Spies in the Land

GRAPES ON A STICK

TIE ON TO STICK HERE

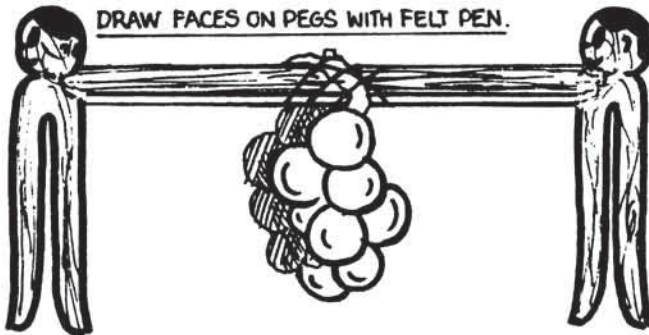


MATERIALS NEEDED

BUNCH OF GRAPES - REAL OR ARTIFICIAL ● LOLLY STICK OR SIMILAR ● FINE TWINE OR FISHING LINE.

AS AN ALTERNATIVE GLUE TWO WOODEN PEGS EITHER END OF THE STICK TO REPRESENT TWO MEN. AS SHOWN BELOW.

DRAW FACES ON PEGS WITH FELT PEN.

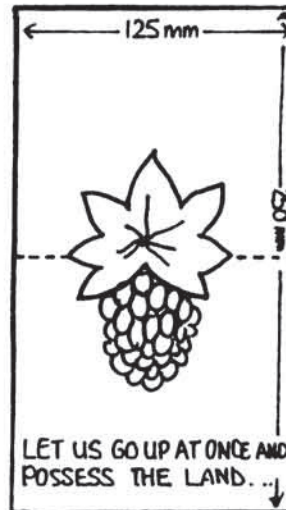


STAND UP CARD

MATERIALS NEEDED

STIFF WHITE CARD ● PURPLE AND GREEN

COLOURED PAPER OR PENCILS ● SCISSORS.



HOW TO MAKE IT

CUT CARD TO 250 mm. X 125 mm. FAINTLY DRAW THE HALF WAY MARK, WHICH IS TO BE THE FOLD. COPY OR PHOTO-COPY THE PICTURE OF THE LEAF AND GRAPES ON PAGE 9 AND PASTE ONTO CARD AS SHOWN IN ILLUSTRATION.

CUT OUT THE TOP HALF OF THE LEAF (ABOVE THE FOLD) AND THEN FOLD CARD ALONG THE FOLD LINE. SCORE WITH A KNIFE ALONG FOLD LINE TO HELP FOLDING EASIER.

WRITE SUITABLE QUOTATION ON THE BOTTOM OF THE CARD.



CLASS ACTIVITY

CHILDREN TO STICK ON COLOURED PAPER OR COLOUR IN GRAPES AND LEAF WITH COLOURED PENCILS.

WALL HANGING

MATERIALS NEEDED

PAPER PLATE (1 PER CHILD) ● CUT-OUT

PICTURE PROVIDED ON PAGE 8.
 MAKE SURE THE BASE OF THE PLATE
 IS APPROX. THE SAME SIZE AS PICTURE.
 ● PIECE OF RIBBON OR CORD.

HOW TO MAKE

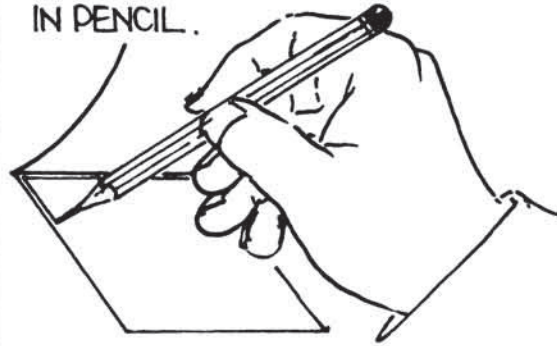
GLUE A SMALL LENGTH OF CORD OR RIBBON TO THE BACK OF THE PLATE FOR USE AS A HANGER. CUT OUT PICTURE ON PAGE 8 AND BRING TO CLASS WITH GLUE AND COLOURED PENCILS.



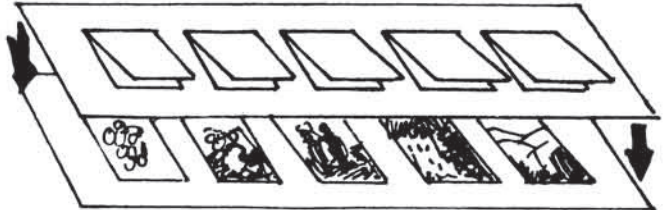
CLASS ACTIVITY

CHILDREN TO COLOUR IN PICTURE. TEACHER TO GLUE ONTO PLATE. CHILDREN TO TAKE HOME.

OUTLINE OF WINDOW ONTO BOTTOM CARD IN PENCIL.

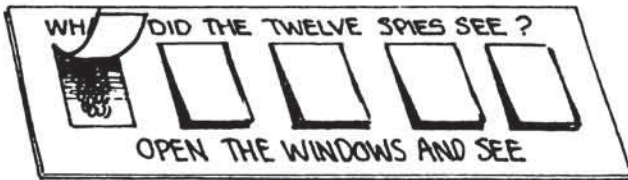


THE BOTTOM CARD WILL THEN BE LEFT WITH 5 SQUARES. COPY OR PHOTOCOPY THE 5 PICTURES ON PAGES 7 AND 8. PASTE THE PICTURES ON TOP OF THESE SQUARES AND COLOUR IN AS DESIRED. GLUE TOP AND BOTTOM CARDS TOGETHER MAKING SURE THE WINDOWS CORRESPOND TO THE PICTURES UNDERNEATH.

WHAT DID THE 12 SPIES SEE? -

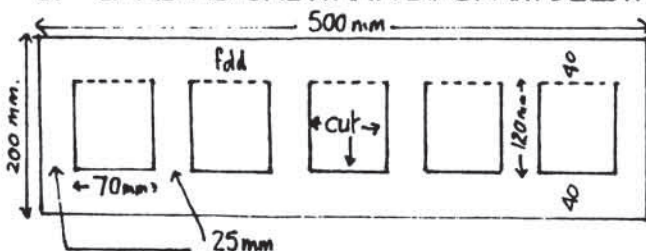


MATERIALS REQUIRED.

TWO PIECES OF CARD 500 mm X 200 mm
 ● SCISSORS OR PAPER KNIFE ● FELT PENS ● PICTURES PROVIDED ON PAGE 7 COPY OR PHOTOCOPY.

HOW TO MAKE IT

CUT OUT WINDOWS ON ONE OF THE PIECES OF CARD AS SHOWN IN DIAGRAM BELOW



WINDOWS SHOULD BE 120 mm X 70 mm. NOW PLACE THE CARD WITH THE WINDOWS ON TOP OF THE BASE CARD. OPEN WINDOWS ONE BY ONE AND DRAW

CLASS ACTIVITY

THIS WILL PROVE TO BE A MARVELLOUS LITTLE AID TO THIS EXCITING LESSON. LET THE CHILDREN OPEN THE WINDOWS ON ANSWERING A QUESTION.



12 SPIES

MATERIALS REQUIRED.

PIECE OF PAPER, 13 TIMES THE WIDTH OF INITIAL FOLD. EG. THE WIDTH OF THE EXAMPLE



DO NOT CUT HERE!

OPPOSITE IS 13 mm. TIMES THIS BY 13 AND THE WIDTH OF PAPER NEEDED FOR 12 SPIES IS 169 mm.

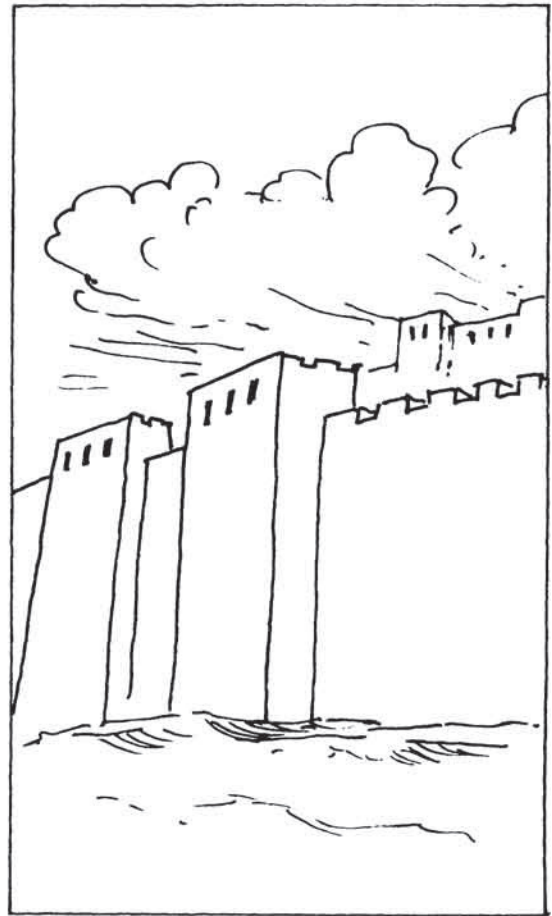
HOW TO MAKE IT.

FOLD PAPER ACCORDIAN STYLE 12 X. THIS WILL MAKE 13 PANELS. DRAW 1/2 A SPY ON END PANEL AND CUT OUT AREA WHICH HAS BEEN SHADED ON DIAGRAM. WRITE JOSHUA & CALEB ON TWO OF THE SPIES.

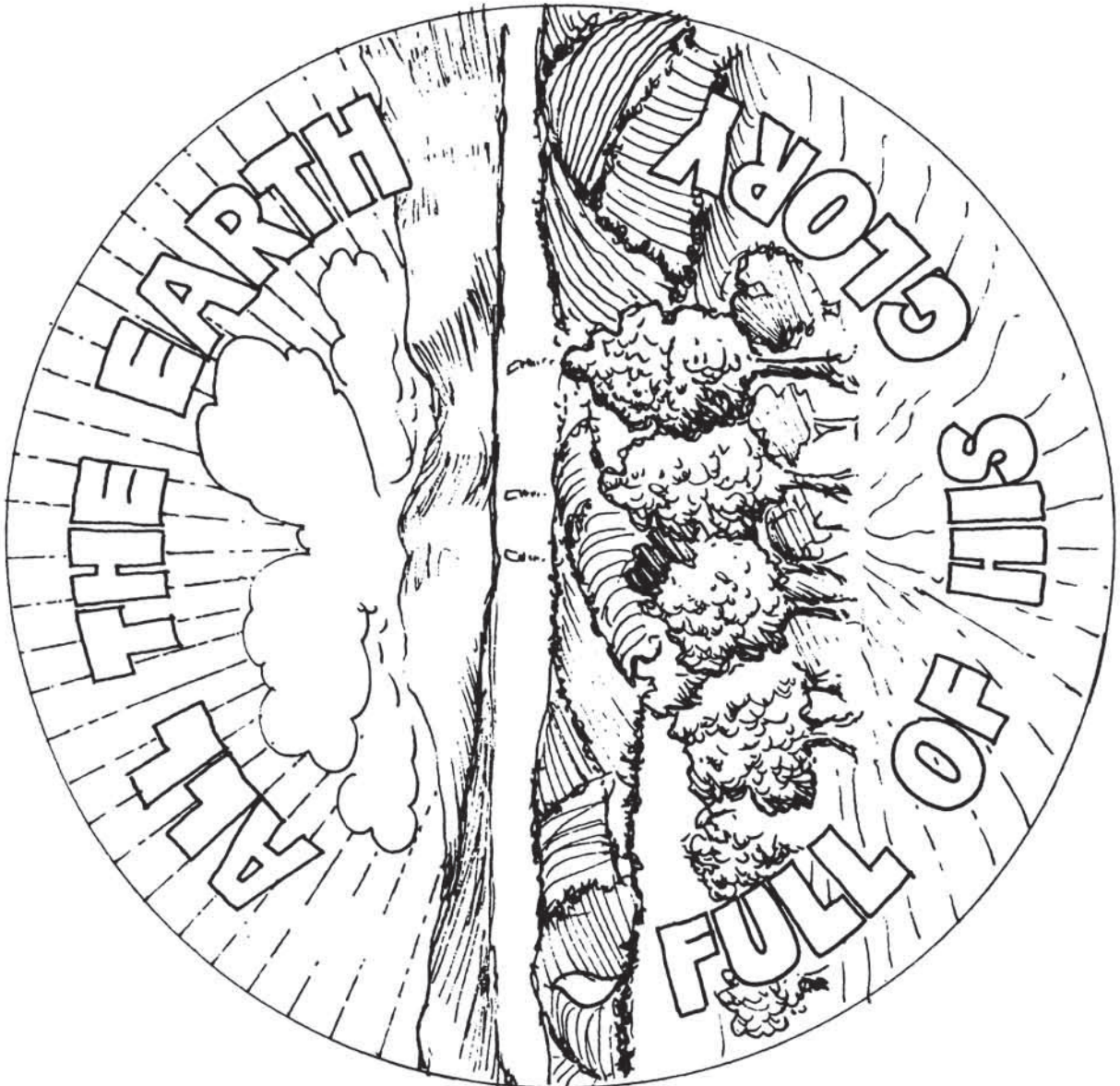

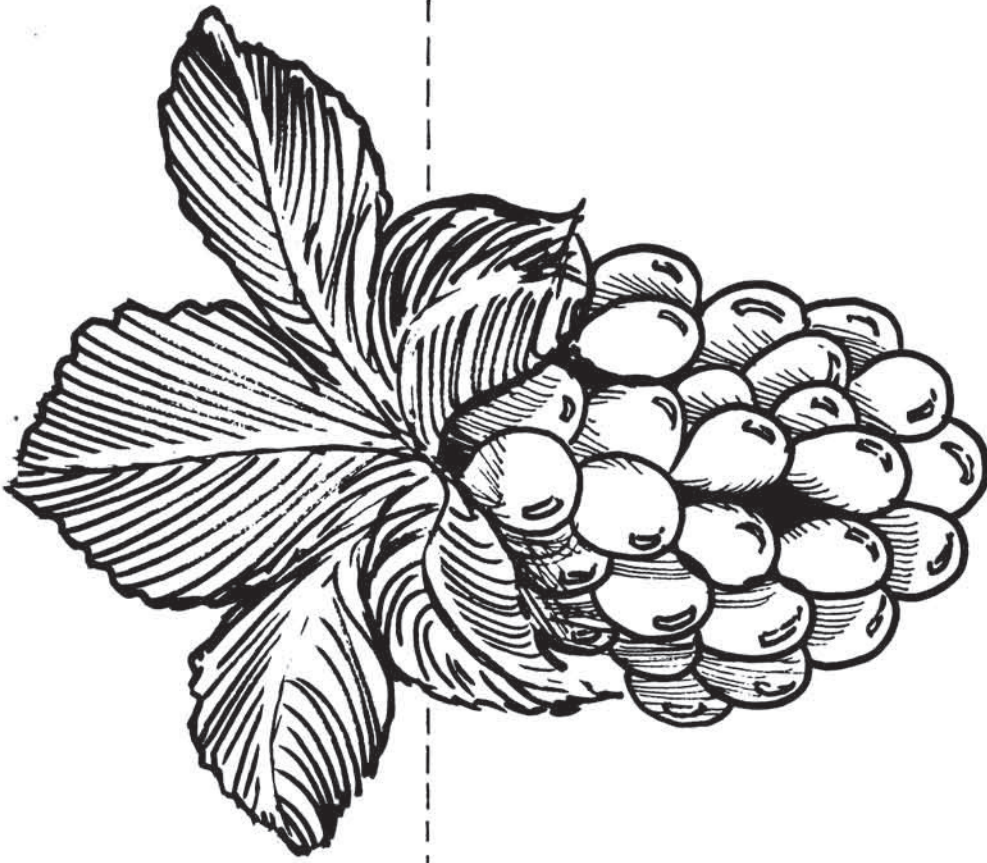

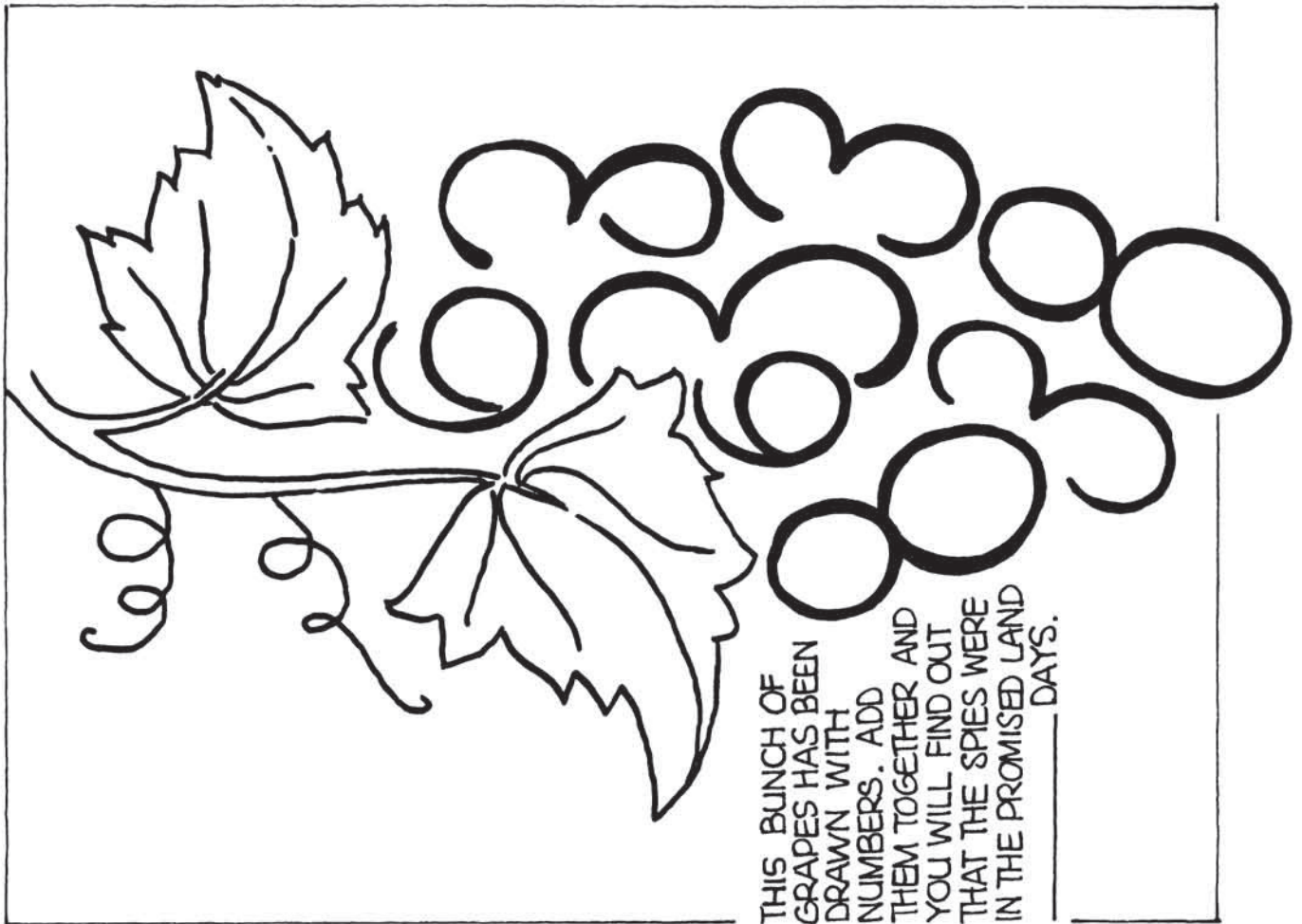
