


QUAILS



MATERIALS REQUIRED

• CUT OUT QUAILS • STRING OR FISHING WIRE • THIN DOWEL OR TWIG • STICKY TAPE • COLDURED PENCILS.

HOW TO MAKE IT

PREPARE QUAIL CUT OUTS (ABOUT 6 PER CHILD) BY PHOTOCOPYING THE DRAWING PROVIDED ON PAGE 4 . OR YOU CAN DRAW YOUR OWN. ATTACH A PIECE OF STRING 300 mm LONG TO EACH USING "STICKY TAPE". PREPARE ONE STICK PER CHILD, APPROX 6 mm ROUND BY 300 mm LONG.

CLASS ACTIVITY

IN CLASS CHILDREN TO COLOUR IN QUAIL CUT OUTS. TEACHER TO HELP CHILDREN FIX STRINGS TO THE END OF THE STICK. CHILDREN TO TAKE HOME QUAILS AT END OF LESSON.





FOOD CUT OUT OF ADVERTISING LITERATURE FROM FOOD STORES. (FISH,

CUCUMBERS, MELONS, LEEKS, ONIONS
GARLIC PAPER PLATE GLUE
GLITTER, COLOURED PENCILS.

HOW TO MAKE IT.

CUT OUT APPROPRIATE FOOD PICTURES APPROX, 4 OR 5 PER CHILD, PURCHASE PAPER PLATES I PER CHILD.

CLASS ACTIVITY

CHILDREN TO SELECT ONE OF EACH TYPE OR AS AN ALTERNATIVE THEY ARE GIVEN THE ITEMS BY THE TEACHER ON ANSWERING A QUESTION CORRECTLY. CHILDREN THEN GLUE PICTURES ONTO THE PLATE AND THEN DECORATE WITH COLOURED PENCILS AND GLITTER. TAKE HOME.

INGREDIENTS.

2 CUPS PLAIN FLOUR • 6025 MARGARINE


• I TABLE SPOON CASTER SUGAR

● I EGG YOLK ● I TABLE SPOON COLD WATER.

HOW TO MAKE IT

SIFT FLOUR AND RUB IN MARGARINE.
BEAT EGGYOUK WITH WATER AND ADD
TO FLOUR MIXTURE. WRAP IN PLASTIC
AND PUT IN FRIDGE TILL COLD. THEN
ROLL OUT LIKE PASTRY AND CUT OUT
BISCUITS. BAKE IN MODERATE OVEN
FOR 15-20 MINUTES.
IF MAKING QUAILS DECORATE WITH
CHOCOLATE SPRINCES.





MATERIALS REQUIRED

METAL COAT HANGER • 2 LENGTHS OF WOODEN DOWEL, APROX. 200 mm LONG • STRING OR PISHING LINE • DISH OR PLATE • COTTON WOOL • COPY OR PHOTO COPY DRAWINGS OF FOOD, PROVIDED ON PAGE 4.

HOW TO MAKE IT.

CUT OUT PICTURES OF FOOD AND COLOUR IN. ATTACH A SMALL LENGTH OF STRING OR FISHING LINE TO THE FOOD CUT-OUTS AND JOIN TO PIECES OF DOWEL. ATTACH DOWELS TO COAT HANGER AS SHOWN IN ILLUSTRATION. MAKE SURE SIDES ARE BALANCED. IN ADDITION TO THIS PREPARE A BOWL OF COTTON WOOL FLUFFED UP OR KAPOCK.

CLASS ACTIVITY

TEACHER TO ILLUSTRATE AND CONTRAST GODS FOOD AND MANS FOOD.

WITH FEATHERS.




MATERIALS REQUIRED

COPY OR PHOTO-COPY QUAILS PROVIDED ON PAGE 4 • GLUE • COLOURED PENCILS • QUAIL FEATHERS OR CUT FEATHERS OFF A FEATHER DUSTER.

CLASS ACTIVITY.

IN PREPARATION FOR THE CLASS, CUTOUT THE QUAIL SHAPES. IN CLASS, CHILDREN TO COLOUR IN THEIR QUAIL. THEN AS A REWARD FOR ANSWERING QUESTIONS HAND OUT FEATHERS AND THEN GLUE ONTO QUAILS. CHILDREN TAKE THEM HOME.







CLASS ACTIVITY
