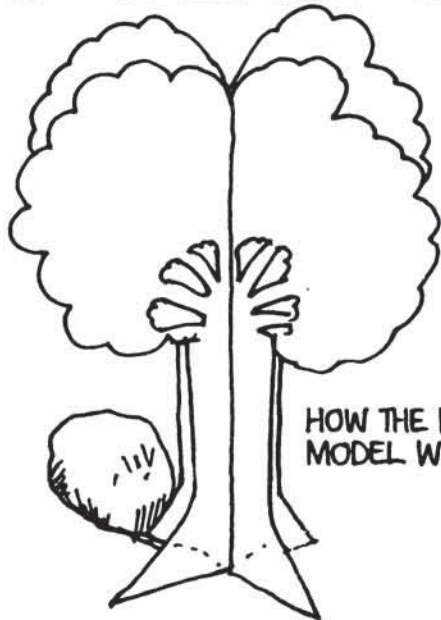

TREE & STONE



HOW THE FINISHED MODEL WILL LOOK.



MATERIALS REQUIRED.

- A PIECE OF CARD (X2) 150mm. X 140mm.
- SCISSORS OR SHARP KNIFE. ● GLUE.

HOW TO MAKE IT.

FOLD CARD IN HALF AND DRAW HALF A TREE. USE THE TREE OPPOSITE AS A TEMPLATE.

CUT OUT TREE WITH CARD STILL FOLDED. REPEAT WITH THE OTHER PIECE OF CARD. SLIT ONE OF THE CARDS FROM THE TOP, TO ABOUT HALF WAY DOWN AND THE OTHER FROM THE BOTTOM TO HALF WAY UP.

SLIDE THEM TOGETHER WITH THE TWO SHAPES PERPENDICULAR TO EACH OTHER, AND STAND THE TREE UP.

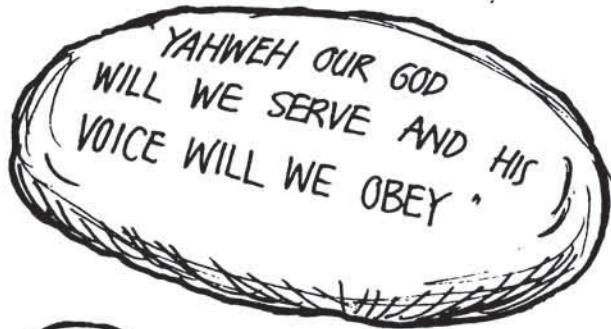


CUT OUT A STONE SHAPED PIECE OF CARD AND GLUE TO THE BASE OF THE TREE.



MAKE UP A SMALL CARDBOARD TREE AND STICK A SOFT LOLLY IN PAPER TO THE BASE.

FUN WITH ROCKS



MATERIALS REQUIRED.

SMOOTH STONES, SMALL OR LARGE. CAN BE FOUND NEAR RIVERS OR ON THE COAST. ● WHITE HOUSE PAINT (NOT GLOSS) ● PAINT BRUSH ● FELT TIP PENS ● VARNISH.

HOW TO MAKE IT.

PICTURED ABOVE ARE JUST TWO IDEAS ON HOW TO DECORATE SMOOTH STONES. FIRST CLEAN STONES SO THEY ARE FREE FROM DUST AND DIRT. PAINT THE SURFACE OF THE STONE WITH FLAT WHITE HOUSE PAINT AND ALLOW A FEW HOURS TO DRY. FROM HERE A NUMBER OF METHODS MAY BE USED TO COMPLETE THE DESIGN ON THE STONES.

(a) WRITE THE ABOVE QUOTATION ON THE STONE WITH FELT TIP PEN. VARNISH IF YOU WISH THE STONE TO HAVE A SHINY SURFACE.

(b) CHILDREN MAY WRITE A QUOTATION DURING THE CLASS, OR AS AN ALTERNATIVE DRAW OR PAINT A PICTURE OF A TREE. CHILDREN TO TAKE HOME AFTER CLASS.
