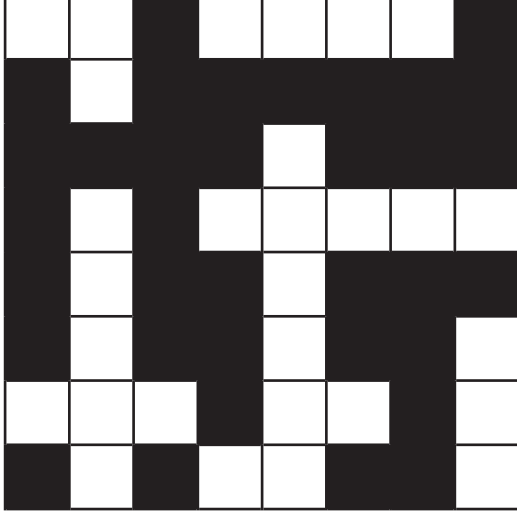


Lesson 12 Joshua Dies

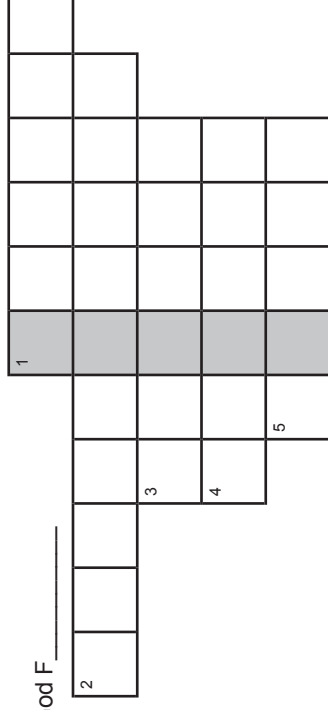
