





### **How to use these maps:**

**These maps are tabloid, you will need to select letter size paper if you want your map to print on normal paper**

### **Make a placemat:**

**Print on tabloid paper or use Adobe to print a tiled poster on letter size paper and tape it together**

**Color, add details and features**

**Glue the map to cardstock**

**Use plastic contact film to overlay the top of the map**

**You should be able to use sharpie pens to trace routes on the map**

### **Make a bulletin board:**

**Print a tiled poster to fit your board, tape it together**

**Use as is or use a window to trace onto roll paper (Kraft Brown Paper makes an antique looking map)**

**Color, add details and features.**

**(At this scale its fun to add illustrations like sailing ships, desert caravans, architecture, a compass rose, etc)**

**Use pins and string to trace routes**

**Make a beautiful map border with Egyptian hieroglyphics or hebrew letters**

**Use a dip pen and title your map in a calligraphy script**
