

Restoration of Judah. ZECHARIAH 13. Repentance of Jerusalem.

salem ^aa cup of ²trembling unto all the people round about, ³when they shall be in the siege both against Judah *and* against Jerusalem.

3 ¶ And ^cin that day will I make Jerusalem a burdensome stone for all people: all that burden themselves with it shall be cut in pieces, though all the people of the earth be gathered together against it.

4 In that day, saith the LORD, ^dI will smite every horse with ^eastonishment, and his rider with madness: and ^fI will open mine eyes upon the house of Judah, and will smite every horse of the people with blindness.

5 And the governors of Judah shall say in their heart, ^gThe inhabitants of Jerusalem shall be my strength in the LORD of hosts their God.

6 ¶ In that day will I make the governors of Judah ^hlike an hearth of fire among the wood, and like a torch of fire in a sheaf; and ⁱthey shall devour all the people round about, on the right hand and on the left: and Jerusalem shall be inhabited again in her own place, *even* in Jerusalem.

7 The LORD also shall save the tents of Judah first, that the glory of the house of David and the glory of the inhabitants of Jerusalem do not magnify *themselves* against Judah.

8 In that day shall the LORD ^jdefend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and ^khe that is ^lfeeble among them at that day shall be as David; and the house of David shall be as God, as the angel of the LORD before them.

9 ¶ And it shall come to pass in that day, *that* I will seek ^mto destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem.

10 And ⁿI will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplica-

tions; and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as ^oone mourneth for *his* only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for *his* firstborn.

11 In that day shall there be a great mourning in Jerusalem, ^pas the mourning of Hadadrimmon in the valley of ^qMegiddon.

12 And the land shall mourn, ^revery family apart; the family of the house of David apart, and ^stheir wives apart; the family of the house of ^tNathan apart, and their wives apart;

13 The family of the house of Levi apart, and their wives apart; the family ^uof ^vShimei apart, and their wives apart;

14 All the families that remain, every family apart, and their wives apart.

CHAPTER 13.

¹The fountain of purgation for Jerusalem, ²from idolatry, and false prophecy. ⁷The death of Christ, and the trial of a third part.

¶ **I**n that day there shall be ³a fountain opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for ⁴uncleanness.

6 And *one* shall say unto him, What *are* these wounds in *thine* hands? Then he shall answer, *Those* with which I was wounded *in* the house of my friends.

8 And it shall come to pass, *that* in all the land, saith the LCDR, ⁵two parts therein shall be cut off *and* die; but the third shall be left therein.

9 And I will bring the third part through the fire, and will ⁶refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried: ⁷they shall call on my name, and I will hear them: I will say, It *is* my people: and they shall say, The LORD *is* my God.

CHAPTER 12.

¶ **T**HE burden of the word of the LORD for Israel, saith the LCDR, which stretcheth forth the heavens, and layeth the foundation of the earth, and ²formeth the spirit of man within him.
