

32 This Jesus \*hath God raised up, whereof we all are / witnesses.

33 Therefore <sup>h</sup>being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received <sup>i</sup>of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath <sup>i</sup>shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.

34 For David is not ascended <sup>o</sup>into the heavens: but he saith himself, <sup>p</sup>The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand,

35 Until I make thy foes thy footstool.

36 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that <sup>i</sup>God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ.

37 ¶ Now when they heard *this*, they were <sup>p</sup>pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men *and* brethren, <sup>c</sup>what shall we do?

38 Then Peter said unto them, <sup>e</sup>Repent, and <sup>f</sup>be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ <sup>h</sup>for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

39 For the promise is unto you, and <sup>i</sup>to your children, and to all that are <sup>k</sup>afar off, *even* as many as the Lord our God shall call.

40 And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this <sup>m</sup>untoward generation.

41 ¶ Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added *unto them* <sup>o</sup>about three thousand <sup>p</sup>souls.

42 And they <sup>q</sup>continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.
