15 Then ^owhen lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, ^obringeth forth death.

16 Do not err, my beloved brethren.

17 ^oEvery good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from ^othe Father of lights, ^owith whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

18 ^oOf his own will ^obegat he us with the word of truth, ^othat we should be a kind of ^ofirst-fruits of his creatures.
