¹ Being justified by faith, we have peace with God, ¹⁷ and righteousness and life by Jesus Christ.

THEREFORE ^r being justified by faith, we have ^l peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:

² By whom also ^v we have access by faith into this grace ^b wherein we stand, and ^c rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

³ And not only so, but ^d we glory in tribulations also: ^e knowing that tribulation worketh patience;

⁴ And patience, ^v experience; and experience, hope:

⁵ And ⁱ hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

out strength, ² in due time ^a Christ died for the ungodly.

⁷ For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die.

⁸ But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, ^b while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

⁹ Much more then, being now justified ^b by his blood, ^e we shall be saved from wrath through him.

¹⁰ For if, ^g when we were enemies, ^h we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by ^h his life.

¹¹ And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the ^o atonement.

¹² Wherefore, as ⁿ by one man sin entered into the world, and ^o death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, ^o for that all have sinned:

¹⁸ Therefore as ³ by the offence of one *judgment* came upon all men to condemnation; even so ⁴ by the righteousness of *the free gift* came upon ^c all men unto ^d justification of life.

¹⁹ For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous.

²⁰ Moreover ^f the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, ^g grace did much more abound:
