

CHAPTER 12.

¹ God calleth Abram, and blesseth him. ⁴ He departeth with Lot from Haran. ⁶ He journeyeth through Canaan. ¹⁰ He is driven by a famine into Egypt.

NOW the ^oLORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:

² And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing:

³ ^hAnd I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: ⁱand in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

⁴ So Abram departed, as the LORD had spoken unto him; and Lot went with him: and Abram *was* seventy and five years old when he departed out of Haran.

⁷ And the LORD appeared unto Abram, and said, ^hUnto thy seed will I give this land: and there builded he an altar unto the LORD, who appeared unto him.

CHAPTER 13.

¹⁴ ¶ And the LORD said unto Abram, after that Lot was separated from him, Lift up now thine eyes, and look from the place where thou art ^anorthward, and southward, and eastward, and westward:

¹⁵ For all the land which thou seest, ^cto thee will I give it, and ^dto thy seed for ever.

¹⁶ And ^eI will make thy seed as the dust of the earth: so that if a man can number the dust of the earth, *then* shall thy seed also be numbered.

¹⁷ Arise, walk through the land in the length of it and in the breadth of it; for I will give it unto thee.

¹⁸ Then Abram removed *his* tent, and came and dwelt in the ²plain of Mamre, ^cwhich *is* in Hebron, and built there an altar unto the LORD.
