¹ David, praying for Solomon, sheweth the goodness and glory of his kingdom in type, and of Christ's in truth. ¹⁸ He blesseth God *A Psalm* ¹ for Solomon.

GIVE the king thy judgments, O God, and thy righteousness unto ^a the king's son.

² He shall judge thy people with righteousness, and thy poor with judgment.

³ The ^c mountains shall bring peace to the people, and the little hills, by righteousness.

⁴ He shall judge the poor of the people, he shall save the children of the needy, and shall break in pieces the oppressor.

⁵ They shall fear thee ^{as} long as the sun and moon endure, throughout all generations.

⁶ He shall come down like rain upon ^m the mown grass: as ⁿ showers that water the earth.

⁷ In his days ^o shall the righteous flourish; and ^p abundance of peace ^q so long as the moon endureth.

⁸ He shall have dominion also from sea to sea, and from the river unto ^r the ends of the earth.

⁹ They that dwell in the wilderness shall bow before him; and his enemies ^s shall lick the dust.

¹⁰ The kings of ^t Tarshish and of ^u the isles shall bring presents: the kings of ^v Sheba and ^w Seba shall offer gifts.

¹¹ Yea, all kings ^x shall fall down before him: all nations shall serve him.

¹² For he shall deliver the needy ^y when he crieth; the poor also, and ^z him that hath no helper.

¹³ He shall spare the poor and needy, and shall save the souls of the needy.

¹⁴ He shall redeem their soul from deceit and violence: and ^{aa} precious shall their blood be in his sight.
