CHAPTER 4.

His solemn charge to Timothy. 6 The nearness of his death. 9 Directions to Timothy.

CHARGE thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, q who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom;

2 Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.

3 For the time will come when they will not endure "sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears:

4 And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and a shall be turned unto fables.
