

Lesson 14 Hezekiah - Judah's Greatest King

¹⁷For there were many in the congregation that were not sanctified: therefore the Levites had the charge of the killing of the passovers for **(3 Across)** one *that* was not clean, to sanctify *them* unto the LORD. ¹⁸For a multitude of the people, even many of Ephraim, and Manasseh, Issachar, and Zebulun, had not cleansed themselves, yet did they eat the passover otherwise than it was written. But Hezekiah prayed for them, saying, The **(1 Across)** LORD **(2 Across)** every one ¹⁹*That* **(4 Across)** his **(5 Across)** to seek God, the LORD God of his fathers, though *he* be not cleansed according to the purification of the sanctuary. ²⁰And the LORD hearkened to Hezekiah, and healed the people.

²¹And the children of Israel that were present at Jerusalem kept the feast of unleavened bread **(17 Across)** days with great **(12 Across)**: and the Levites and the priests praised the LORD **(9 Across)** by day, *singing* with loud instruments unto the LORD. ²²And Hezekiah spake comfortably unto all the Levites that taught the good knowledge of the LORD: and they did eat throughout the feast seven days, **(10 Across)** peace offerings, and making confession to the LORD God of their fathers. ²³And the whole assembly took counsel to keep other seven days: and they kept *other* seven days with **(12 Across)**. ²⁴For Hezekiah king of **(13 Across)** did give to the congregation a **(16 Across)** bullocks and seven thousand sheep; and the princes gave to the congregation a thousand bullocks and ten thousand **(14 Across)**: and a great number of **(15 Across)** sanctified themselves. ²⁵And all the **(8 Across)** of **(13 Across)**, with the priests and the Levites, and all the congregation that came out of **(18 Across)**, and the strangers that came out of the land of Israel, and that dwelt in **(13 Across)** **(6 Across)**. ²⁶So there was great joy in Jerusalem: for since the time of **(21 Across)** the son of David king of **(18 Across)** *there* was not the like in Jerusalem. ²⁷Then the priests the Levites arose and blessed the people: and their voice was heard, and their prayer came *up* to his holy **(19 Across)** place, even unto **(20 Across)**.
