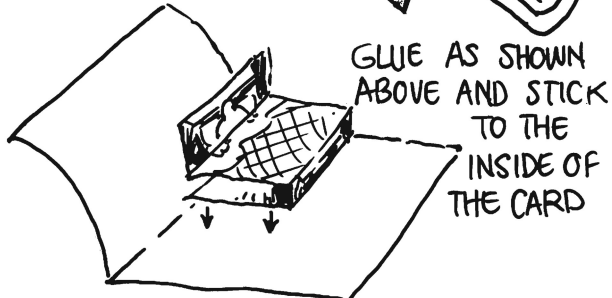
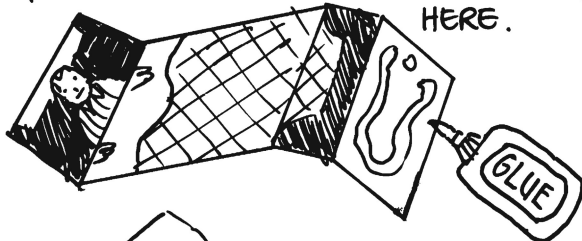
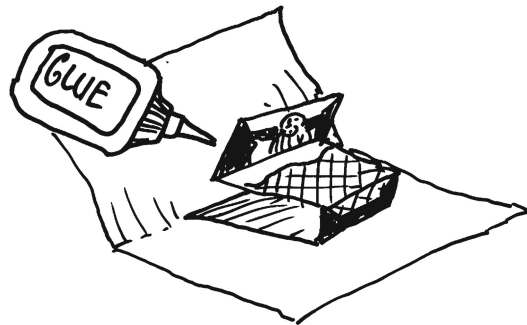
FOLDING FIGURE CARD

MATERIALS REQUIRED.

2 PIECES OF HEAVY PAPER 21.5cm x 14cm
AND 17 x 7cm.

HOW TO MAKE.

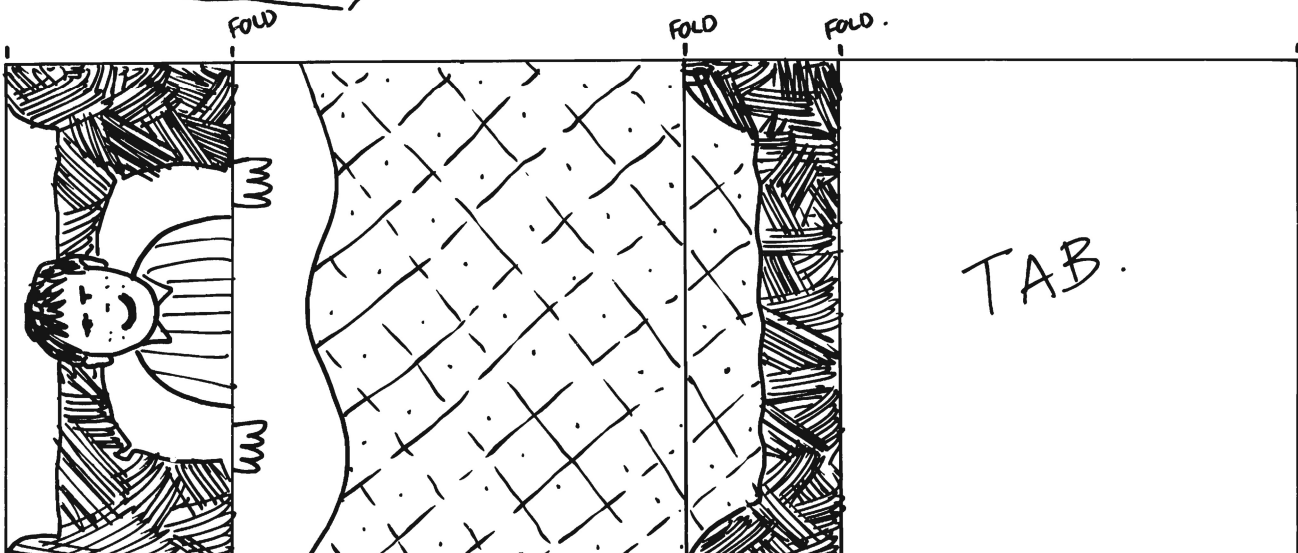
FOLD LARGE PIECE OF PAPER IN HALF AS SHOWN. COPY THE DRAWING AT THE BOTTOM OF THIS PAGE ONTO TO SMALL PIECE OF PAPER AND FOLD AS SHOWN HERE.



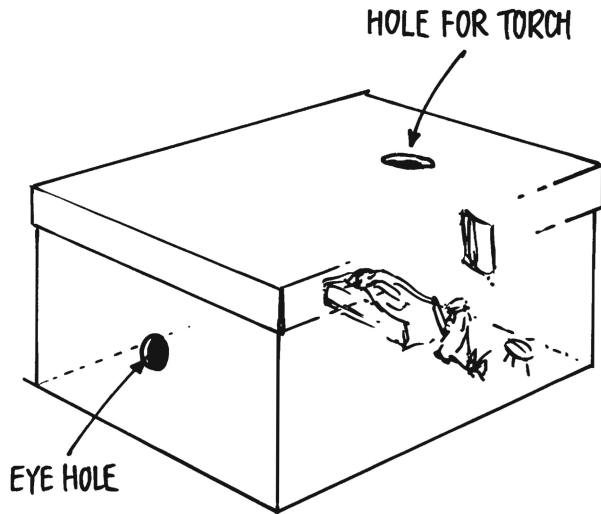
GLUE AS SHOWN ABOVE AND STICK TO THE INSIDE OF THE CARD

APPLY GLUE BEHIND THE TOP SECTION AND CLOSE YOUR CARD. PRESS DOWN FIRMLY. WAIT FOR THE GLUE TO DRY. OPEN THE CARD CAREFULLY. THE TOP SECTION SHOULD NOW BE GLUED IN PLACE. THE FIGURE OR SCENE WILL COLLAPSE WHEN THE CARD IS CLOSED AND WILL POP OPEN WHEN THE CARD IS OPENED.

THE FRONT OF THE CARD MAY BE DECORATED OR HAVE WORDING WHICH IS APPROPRIATE FOR THE LESSON.



PEEP BOX



ALWAYS VERY POPULAR WITH YOUNGER SCHOLARS, THIS PEEP BOX CAN BE USED TIME AND TIME AGAIN FOR OTHER LESSONS.

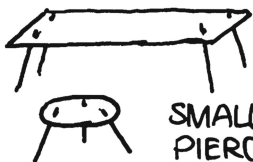
MATERIALS REQUIRED

SHOE BOX OR SOMETHING SIMILAR
 ● PIPE CLEANER FIGURES ● CRAFT KNIFE
 ● TORCH ● FURNITURE AS DESCRIBED IN THIS PROJECT.

HOW TO MAKE IT.

CUT 2 HOLES IN THE BOX. ONE ON THE TOP FOR THE TORCH LIGHT AND ONE AT THE SIDE TO LOOK THROUGH.

HOW TO MAKE THE FURNITURE



THE TABLE AND STOOL CAN BE MADE FROM SMALL PIECES OF CARDBOARD. PIERCE SMALL HOLES IN

THE BOARD AND THEN PUSH THROUGH 'USED' MATCHSTICKS FOR THE LEGS. THESE CAN BE GLUED TO BASE OF BOX IF DESIRED.



FOR A BED GLUE TWO MATCHBOXES TOGETHER AND

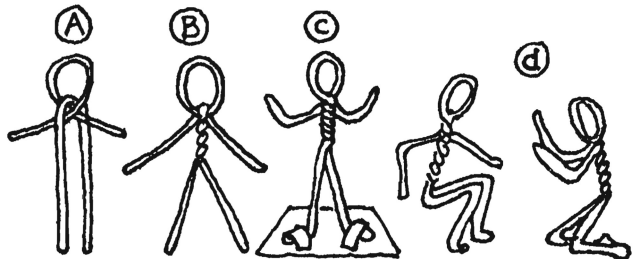
THEN COVER WITH MATERIAL. ADD OTHER BITS OF MATERIAL TO MAKE THE BED LOOK REALISTIC. REMEMBER A BOY HAS TO LIE INSIDE IT.



MAKE THE LAMP FROM PLAYDOUGH OR PLASTICENE. STICK A SMALL PIECE OF CELLOPHANE IN THE LAMP TO GIVE THE EFFECT OF A FLAME WHEN THE TORCH LIGHT HITS IT.

HOW TO MAKE PIPECLEANER FIGURES :

MAKE THE BASIC PIPECLEANER FIGURE AS SHOWN BELOW WITH TWO PIPE CLEANERS.



TO MAKE A HEAD FOR THE FIGURE ATTACH A SMALL BALL OF COTTON WOOL TO THE HEAD LOOP. COVER WITH A SMALL PIECE OF NYLON STOCKING AND FASTEN AT THE NECK WITH A THREAD. PAINT THE FACE OR EMBROIDER.

TO MAKE CLOTHES FOR FIGURES, CUT A TISSUE IN HALF. SLIT ONE PIECE LENGTHWISE TO CENTRE AND PLACE ON THE

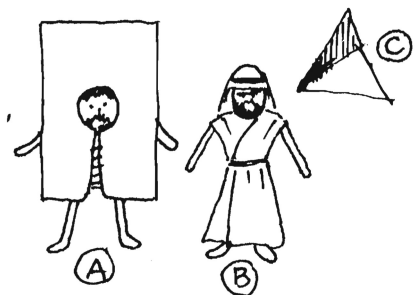
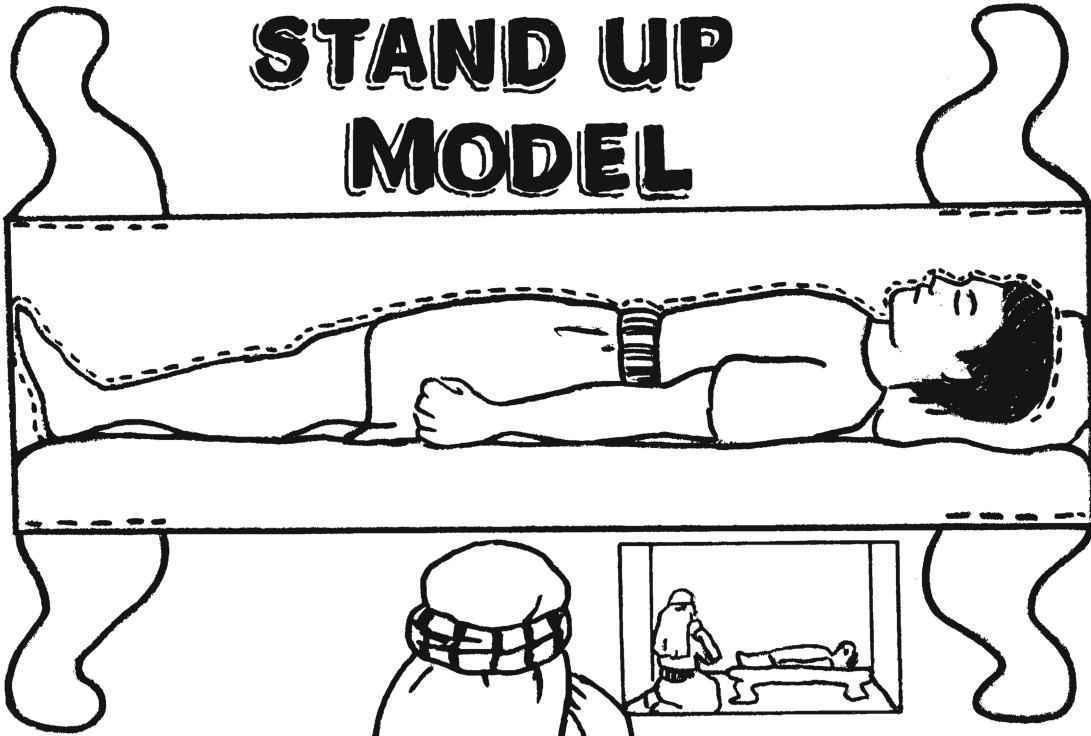


FIGURE AS SHOWN IN (A) FOLD OVER GATHER AROUND WAIST AND TIE WITH THREAD OR A THIN STRIP OF TISSUE WHICH CAN BE GLUED AT THE BACK (B) THE HEAD-DRESS IS MADE BY CUTTING A SQUARE PIECE OF TISSUE AND FOLD INTO A TRIANGLE (C) AND ATTACH TO HEAD WITH THREAD.

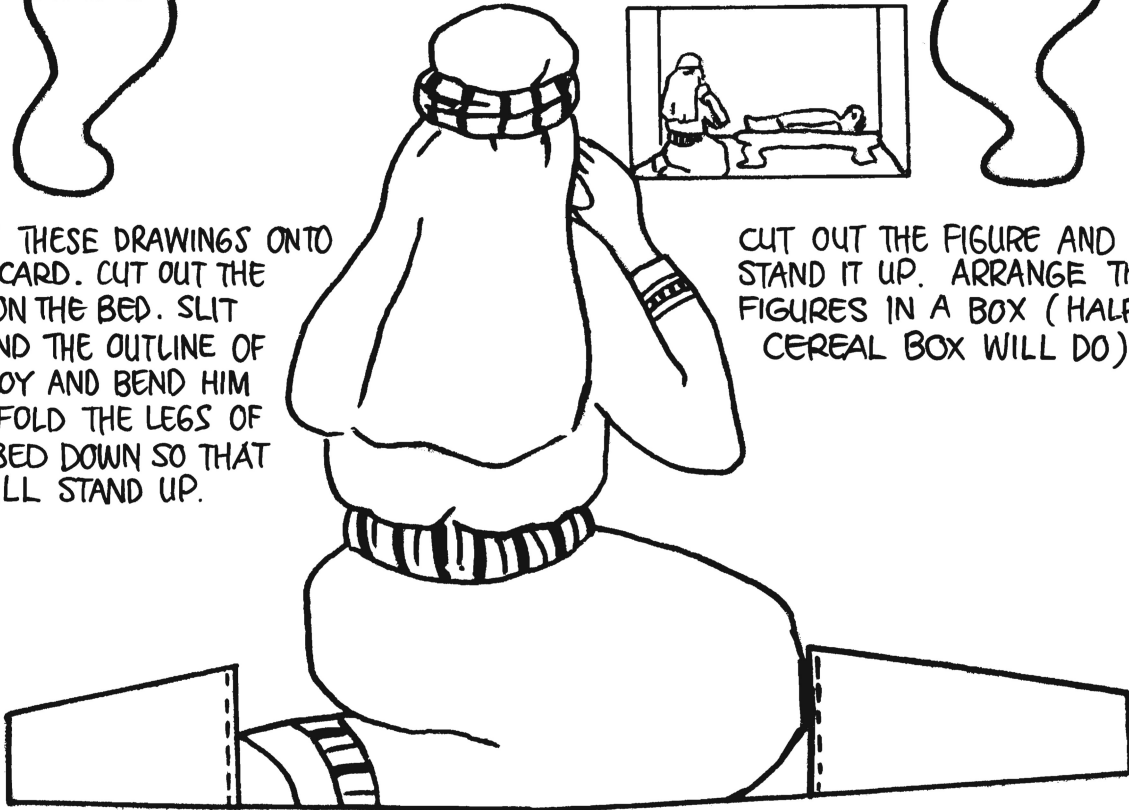
TO FINISH OFF THE 'PEEP BOX' PLACE FURNITURE AND FIGURES IN THE APPROPRIATE PLACES. DRAW AND PAINT IN A DOOR AND A WINDOW.

STAND UP MODEL



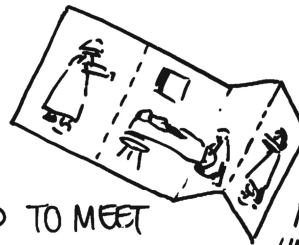
COPY THESE DRAWINGS ONTO THIN CARD. CUT OUT THE BOY ON THE BED. SLIT AROUND THE OUTLINE OF THE BOY AND BEND HIM UP. FOLD THE LEGS OF THE BED DOWN SO THAT IT WILL STAND UP.

CUT OUT THE FIGURE AND STAND IT UP. ARRANGE THE FIGURES IN A BOX (HALF A CEREAL BOX WILL DO)



STORY CARD

COPY THE PATTERN BELOW ONTO THIN CARD. FOLD BACK THE END SECTION UNTIL THE END OF THE STORY THEN FOLD FORWARD TO MEET THE WOMAN.
