


BOX SCENE

MATERIALS REQUIRED


• GHIRT BOX OR SOMETHING SIMILAR


HOW TO MAKE IT

PHOTOCOPY BACKGROUND SCENE ON PAGE AND ENLARGE IF NECESSARY (DEPENDING ON SIZE OF BOX). GLUE BACKGROUND SCENE ONTO THE TOP OF THE CARDBOARD BOX, BENDING AT THE DOTTED LINE SO THAT THE HILLS STAND UPRIGHT.



COMPLETELY REMOVE THE REAR SIDE OF THE BOX. MAKE A SLIT THROUGH THE BOX IN THE MIDDLE OF THE RIVER. PHOTOCOPY FIGURES ON THIS AND GLUE ONTO CARDBOARD, CUT OUT FIGURES AND GWE ONTO DIORAMA WHERE INDICATED. OLUE BOTH PICTURES OF NAAMAN ONTO AN ICECREAM STICK - LEPROUS NAAMAN ON ONE SIDE AND CLEAN NAAMAN ON THE OTHER SIDE . USING THE HOLE AT THE BACK OF THE BOX PUT NAAMAN THROUGH THE SLIT IN THE MIDDLE OF THE RIVER. WITH THE LEPROUS SIDE FACING THE CHILDREN WASH HIM SEVEN TIMES TURN NAAMAN AROUND THE LAST








MATERIALS REQUIRED

• COLOURED PENCIUS • GC1550RS ~ ZIG-ZAG GC1550RS WOULD BE BEST. • COLOURED CARD • RIBBON OR WOOL • GLUE.

HOW TO MAKE IT

PHOTOCOPY THIS PAGE. COLOUR IN THE PICTURE OF NAAMAN. CUT OUT AROUND PICTURE ALONG THE DOTTED LINE. STICK CUT OUT PICTURE ONTO A PIECE OF CARD (CHOOSE SUITABLE SIZE, SHAPE AND COLOUR). FOR BEST STICKING RESULTS USE A GLUE STICK OR

DOUBLE SIDED STICKY TAPE. THE PICTURE COULD BE HUNG BY ATTACHING A RIBBON TO THE BACK (OR WOOL) WHICH CAN BE STUCK ON WITH GUE.





WATER CARD

MATERIALS REQUIRED

BROWN PAINT AND PAINTBRUSHES

THICK WHITE PAPER OR THIN CARDBOARD

HOW TO MAKE IT

GET CHILDREN TO PAINT MUDDY BROWN RIVER ONTO PAPER OR CARDBOARD. (A4) CUT A SLIT IN THE MIDDLE OF THE RIVER.

MAKE NAAMAN USING FIGURES ON PAGE 53 (CLEAN AND UNCLEAN).
GLUE BOTH PICTURES ONTO LONG SMALL PIECE OF CARDBOARD NAAMAN CAN NOW BE WASHED IN THE WATER BY PULLING AND PUSHING HIM THROUGH THE SLIT & COME UP CLEAN (BY TURNING HIM AROUND) THE LAST TIME.

YOU MAY LIKE TO PAINT IN HILLS AND

SKY ETC.

NB. BROWN PAINT CAN BE MADE BY MIXING GREEN AND RED PAINTS.

A LEPEROUS HAND, USING A PLASTIC GLOVE (FROM CHEMIST) STICK ON (WITH ICING) MARSHMALLOWS CUT IN HALF.
