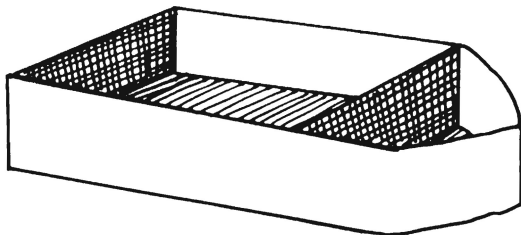
BOAT MODEL.

MATERIALS REQUIRED

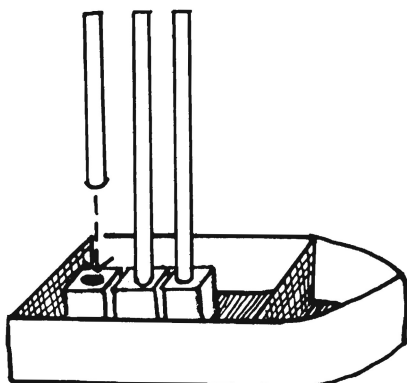
- EMPTY MATCHBOX BASE • SCISSORS
- PLASTIC STRAWS • ODDS AND ENDS OF CARDBOARD AND PAPER SCRAPS
- STRONG GLUE • THREE SQUARE BEADS

HOW TO MAKE IT

CUT A NARROW STRIP OF CARDBOARD THE SAME DEPTH AS THE SIDE OF THE MATCHBOX AND LONG ENOUGH TO MAKE A CURVED PROW TO THE SHIP. GLUE OR STICKY-TAPE THE ENDS OF THE STRIP IN PLACE

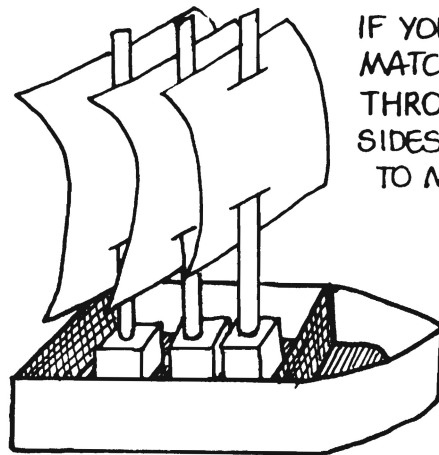


GLUE THE THREE BEADS IN A ROW INTO THE BASE OF THE MATCHBOX. CUT LENGTHS OF PLASTIC STRAWS AND FIX THEM INTO THE EYES OF THE BEADS.

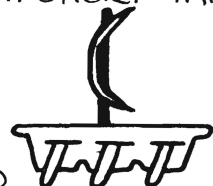


USE THE BASE OF AN EGG CARTON FOR A LARGER SHIP. INSTEAD OF BEADS USE BLUE-TACK OR PLASTICINE TO AFFIX THE MASTS.

CUT SAILS OF COLOURED PAPER OR MATERIAL AND PIERCE SMALL HOLES IN TO TAKE THE MASTS. IF YOU LIKE, SLOT MATCHSTICKS THROUGH THE SIDES OF THE SHIP TO MAKE OARS.



CHILDREN COULD MAKE THEIR OWN SHIP. PROVIDE CHILDREN WITH HALF EGG CARTON, STRAW, ICECREAM STICKS, PAPER CUT TO SHAPE OF SAIL WITH TWO HOLES FOR MAST (TOP & BOTTOM). -POKE STRAW THROUGH 'SAIL' AND IF NECESSARY SECURE WITH STICKY-TAPE. FIX MAST TO 'SHIP' WITH BLUE-TAC, STICKY-TAPE, PLASTICINE OR BEADS AS PER PREVIOUS MODEL. USE ICECREAM STICKS FOR OARS BY POKING THROUGH SIDE OF SHIP AND FIXING WITH STICKY-TAPE. OR USE WALNUT AS BASE FOR SHIP WITH TOOTHPICK FOR MAST, PIECE OF PAPER CUT TO SHAPE AND FIXED ON WITH BLUE-TAC.



ROCKING BOATS

MATERIALS REQUIRED

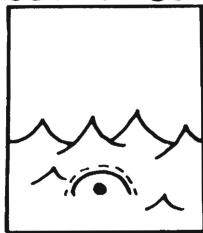
- CARDBOARD • SCISSORS • PAPER FASTENER • BLUE CELLOPHANE OR PAPER

HOW TO MAKE IT

PHOTOCOPY OR COPY SHIP (FIGURE 1) AND CUT OUT.

ON ANOTHER PIECE OF PAPER STICK OR DRAW SEA. TO MAKE SEA USE SMALL SQUARES OF DIFFERENT COLOURED BLUE PAPER; OR OVERLAY GREEN PAPER WITH A WHITE BACK. TEAR THE EDGES OF THE GREEN PAPER SIDWAYS SO THAT THE EDGES WILL FRAY, THUS GIVING WHITE WAVES ON THE SEA. LAY THESE STRIPS OF PAPER OVER ONE ANOTHER FOR THE SEA.

PUNCH A HOLE APPROX. 50cm FROM BOTTOM OF PAPER IN THE CENTRE OF THE SEA. SLIT AN ARC IN THE CENTRE OF PAPER. CENTRE OF ARC APPROX. 1½ CM ABOVE HOLE.



PUNCH HOLE WHERE INDICATED ON SHIP (FIGURE 1). SLIP TAB OF SHIP THROUGH ARC ON WATER SCENE.



FASTEN BOAT AND SCENE TOGETHER BY INSERTING PAPER FASTENER THROUGH HOLES. ROCK BOAT TO AND FRO ROUGHLY FOR STORM.

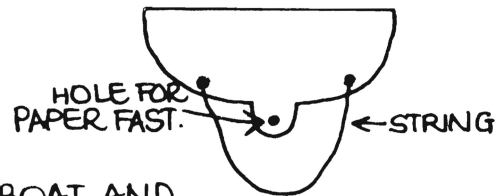
MATERIALS REQUIRED

- SCISSORS • STRING OR WOOL
- PAPER FASTENER • CARDBOARD
- COLOURED PAPER FOR SEA

HOW TO MAKE IT

ON A PIECE OF PAPER MAKE SEA SEE INSTRUCTIONS IN ADJACENT COLUMN. (INCL. SLIT, HOLE)

PHOTOCOPY OR COPY SHIP (FIGURE 1) AND STICK TO CARDBOARD TO STRENGTHEN AND CUT OUT. FASTEN STRING TO BOAT.



FASTEN BOAT AND SEA SCENE AS OUTLINED IN ADJACENT COLUMN, TUCKING STRINGS BEHIND SEA AND PULLING THEM TO ROCK BOAT.

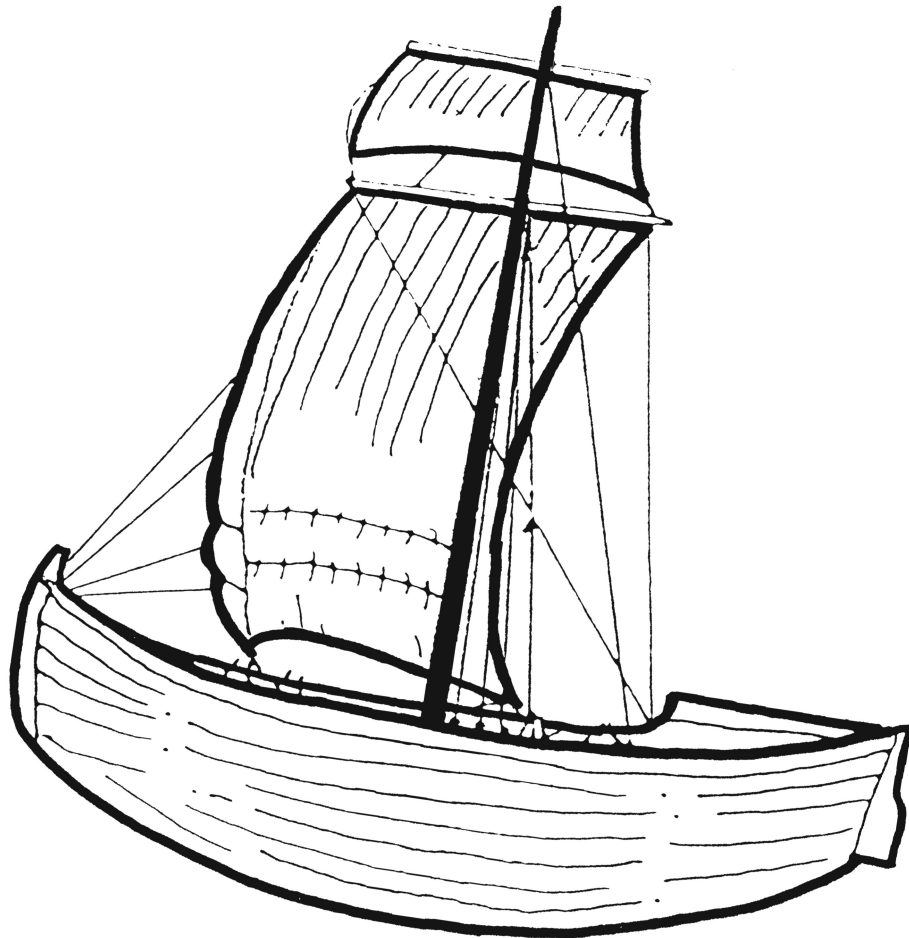
'BACKGROUND IDEAS'

USE A SQUARE OF GREY PAPER FOR STORMY SKY. USE RICE FOR RAIN OR DRAW RAIN WITH WHITE CHALK. USE COTTON WOOL FOR CLOUDS AND MARK ON WITH GREY OR BLACK TEXTA FOR ADDED 'FEROCITY'.

TAKE-HOME TREAT

- USE LICORICE ALLSORTS, BOILED SWEETS AND OTHER SUITABLE LOLLIES AS CARGO IN YOUR SHIP, AND JELLY BABIES FOR THE CREW. YOU COULD ALSO USE MUSK STICKS AS MASTS.
- A SOAP IN THE SHAPE OF A WHALE - READILY AVAILABLE IN SHOPS
- BOILED SWEET IN SHAPE OF FISH

PAPER FISH

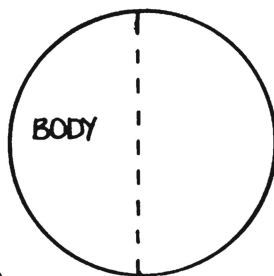
MATERIALS REQUIRED

- CARDBOARD • PENCIL • SCISSORS
- COLOURED PENCILS • GLUE • CUP
- TIN LID • EGG CUP OR SOMETHING SIMILAR TO DRAW AROUND.

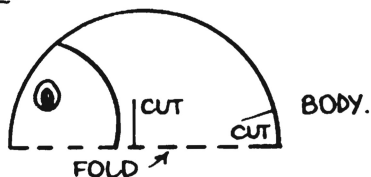
HOW TO MAKE IT

PUT THE CUP ON THE CARDBOARD AND DRAW AROUND IT. CUT OUT THE CIRCLE FOLD IT IN HALF AND GLUE BOTH HALVES TOGETHER.

ON THE HALF CIRCLE DRAW A QUARTER CIRCLE FOR THE FISH'S HEAD AND ADD AN EYE. MAKE A CUT BEHIND THE HEAD YOU DREW. DO



THIS FROM THE FOLDED EDGE UPWARDS. MAKE ANOTHER CUT AT THE TAIL END, FROM THE CURVED EDGE SLANTING DOWN A LITTLE. THESE SLITS WILL HOLD THE FIN AND TAIL.

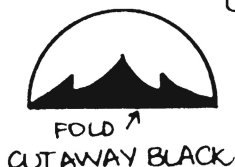


MAKE A SMALLER CIRCLE. CUT IT OUT AND AFTER FOLDING IT, GLUE BOTH HALVES TOGETHER AS BEFORE. CUT THE CURVED EDGE LIKE A SAW, BUT NOT TOO SMALL. CUT DOWN FROM THE CENTRE OF THE CURVE TO ABOUT HALFWAY. SLIP THE FIN BY ITS SLIT INTO THE SLIT OF THE BODY AND YOUR FISH WILL STAND.



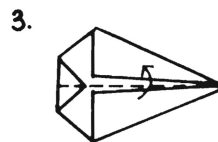
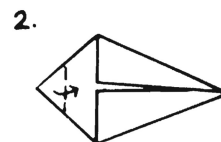
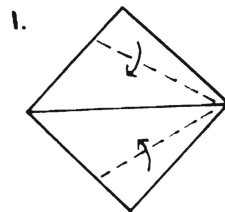
DRAW ANOTHER CIRCLE SMALLER AGAIN. CUT IT OUT, FOLD & STICK LIKE THE OTHER TWO. ON THE FOLDED EDGE

DRAW THE SHAPE OR SIMILAR, TO THAT BELOW AND CUT IT OUT. PUSH THE ROUNDED SIDE INTO THE SLIT YOU CUT INTO THE BACK END OF THE FISH AND YOU HAVE ITS TAIL. IT IS NOW READY FOR YOU TO COLOUR



ORAGAMI FISH.

CUT OUT A PIECE OF PAPER 15cm X 15cm SQUARE ... WHITE, BLUE, GREY.



FOLD EACH TIP OF THE TWO PAPERS INWARDS AND POINT THE TAIL UP.



CUT THE TIP OF THE TAIL A LITTLE BIT



FINISH OFF FACE WITH PEN OR CRAYON.

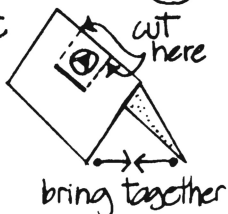
STORY CARD.

MATERIALS REQUIRED.

FOUR PIECES OF CARD (IF TRACING NOT PHOTOCOPYING) ● SCISSORS ● GLUE STICKY TAPE OR A STAPLER ● COLOURED PENCILS.

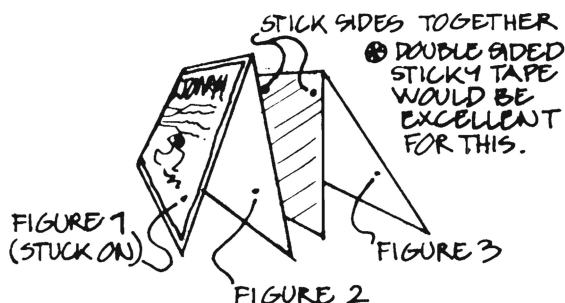
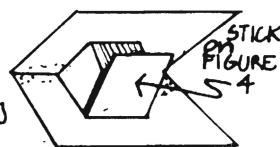
HOW TO MAKE IT.

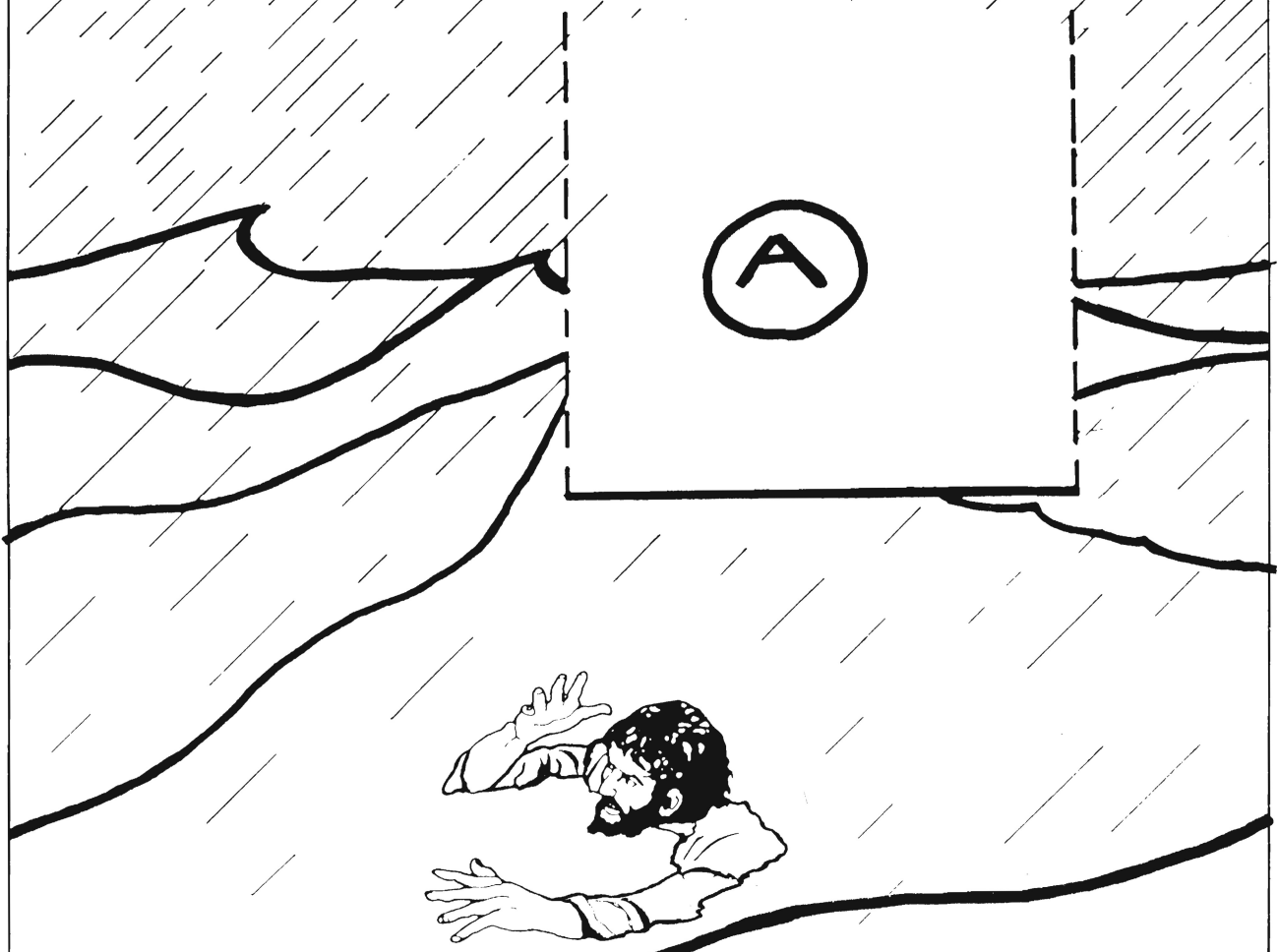
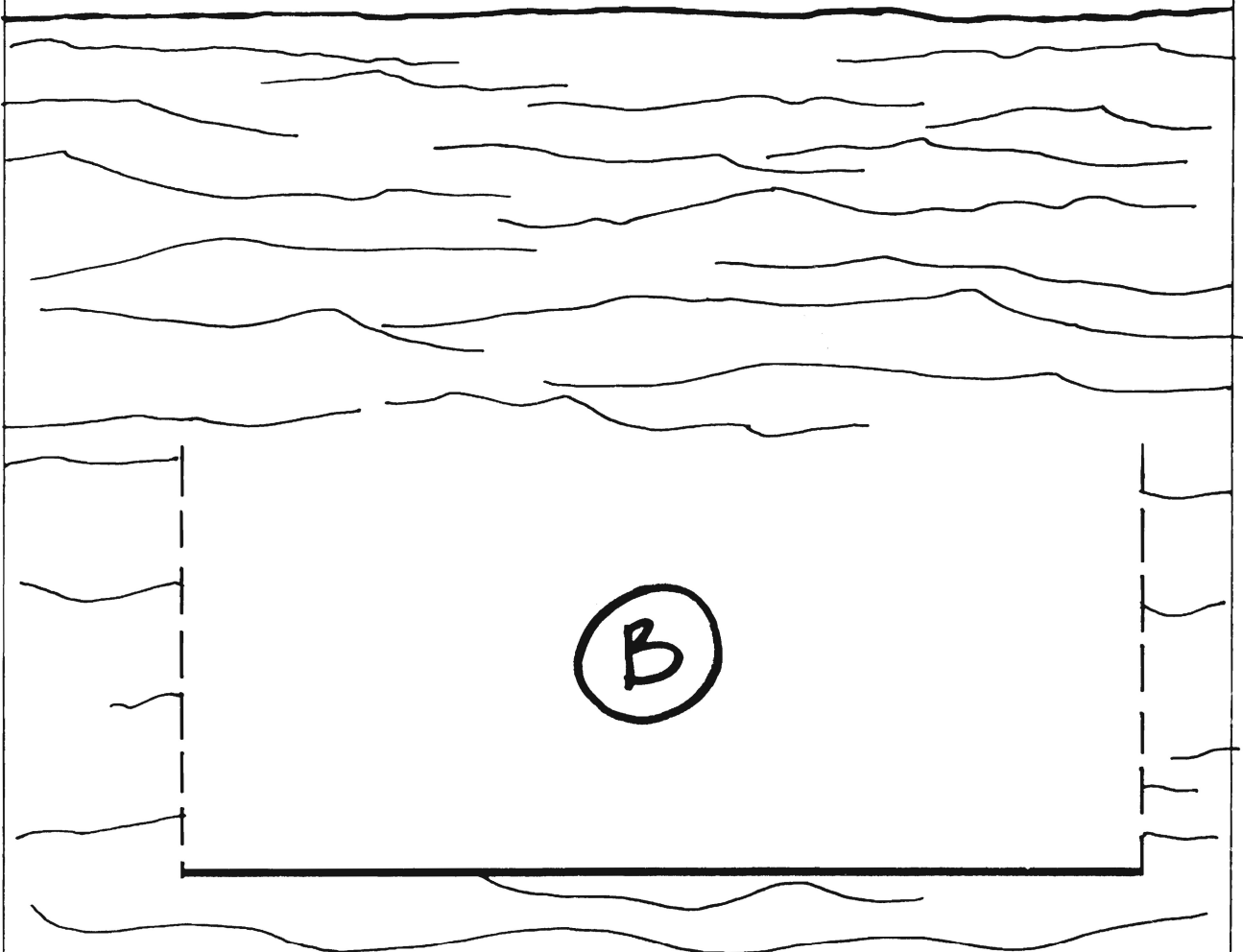


FIGURE 3 CUT OUT ALONG THIS LINE —↓

COPY OR PHOTOCOPY FIGURES 1, 2 AND 3. CUT OUT FIGURE 1 ALONG THE LINE SHOWN AND THEN COLOUR IN JONAH. CUT OUT FIGURE 2 ALONG THE LINE SHOWN AND FOLD THE PICTURE IN HALF AND THEN WITH THE PICTURE FOLDED CUT ALONG THE DOTTED LINES ON EACH SIDE OF THE BOX (A). NEXT FOLD THE PICTURE BACK THE OTHER WAY SO THE PICTURE IS ON THE INSIDE OF THE FOLD AND THEN CUT OUT THE BOAT, FIGURE 4, ALONG THE DOTTED LINE AND STICK IT



ONTO THE BOTTOM FLAP (A) WHICH SHOULD STICK OUT. see picture

CUT OUT FIGURE 3 ALONG LINE SHOWN AND REPEAT INSTRUCTIONS FOR FIGURE 2 EXCEPT STICK THE FISH, FIGURE 5, ONTO (D). PASTE OR STAPLE THE CARDS TOGETHER. see illustration

INTO THE SEA WAVES STRONG

OUR LESSON BE.

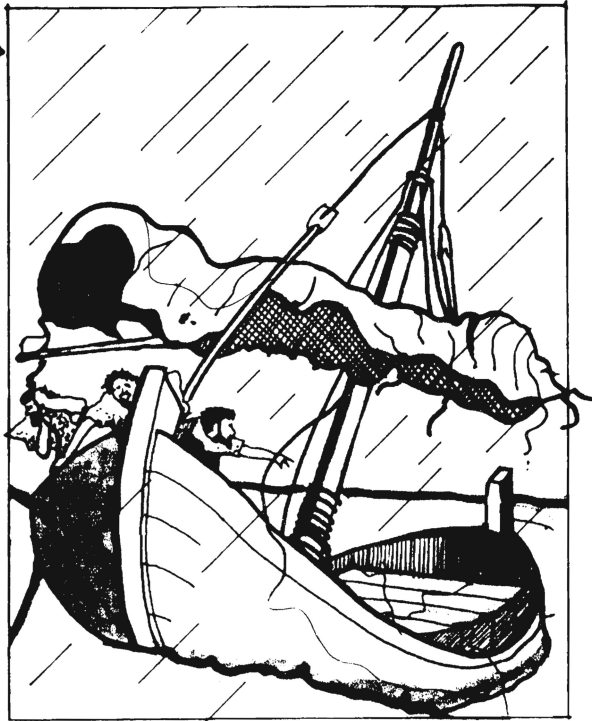


SO JONAH HAD ANOTHER CHANCE

FIGURE 5 CUT OUT ALONG THIS LINE

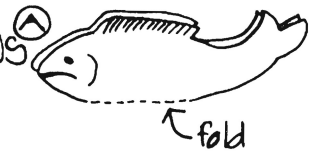

MODEL FISH.

MATERIALS • SCISSORS • GLUE
REQUIRED • COLOURED PENCILS • CRAYONS



HOW TO MAKE IT

COPY OR PHOTOCOPY ONTO PAPER OR CARD. CUT THE FISH OUT AND THEN COLOUR IN. FOLD ALONG DOTTED LINES AND PASTE TOGETHER TOP FINS AND ENDS OF TAILS. SEE (A) WHEN USED WITH JONAH USE A JELLY BABY WHICH MAY BE POPPED IN AND OUT OF THE OPENING AT THE HEAD OF THE FISH.

NOTE IF USED ON WATER A HEAVY COAT OF WAX CRAYON ON THE BOTTOM WILL HELP IT FLOAT.
