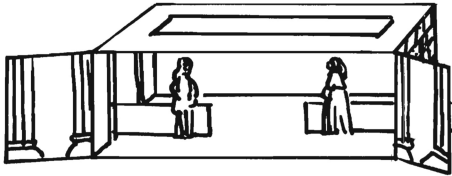

PALACE SCENE.

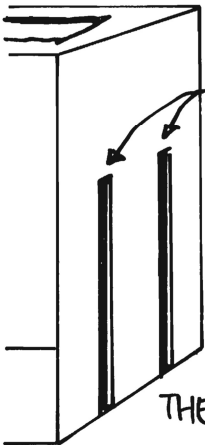


THIS SIMPLE BOX SCENE CAN BE USED FOR MANY LESSONS, WITH A CHANGE OF CHARACTERS OR SCENERY. THE ONE SHOWN ABOVE MAY BE USED TO DEPICT THE MEETING OF SOLOMON AND QUEEN OF SHEBA.

MATERIALS REQUIRED.

CARDBOARD BOX, SHOE BOX OR SIMILAR ● CRAFT KNIFE ● GLUE ● STIFF CARD ● SCRAPS OF MATERIAL OR WALLPAPER TO DECORATE THE INSIDE OF THE BOX.

HOW TO MAKE IT.

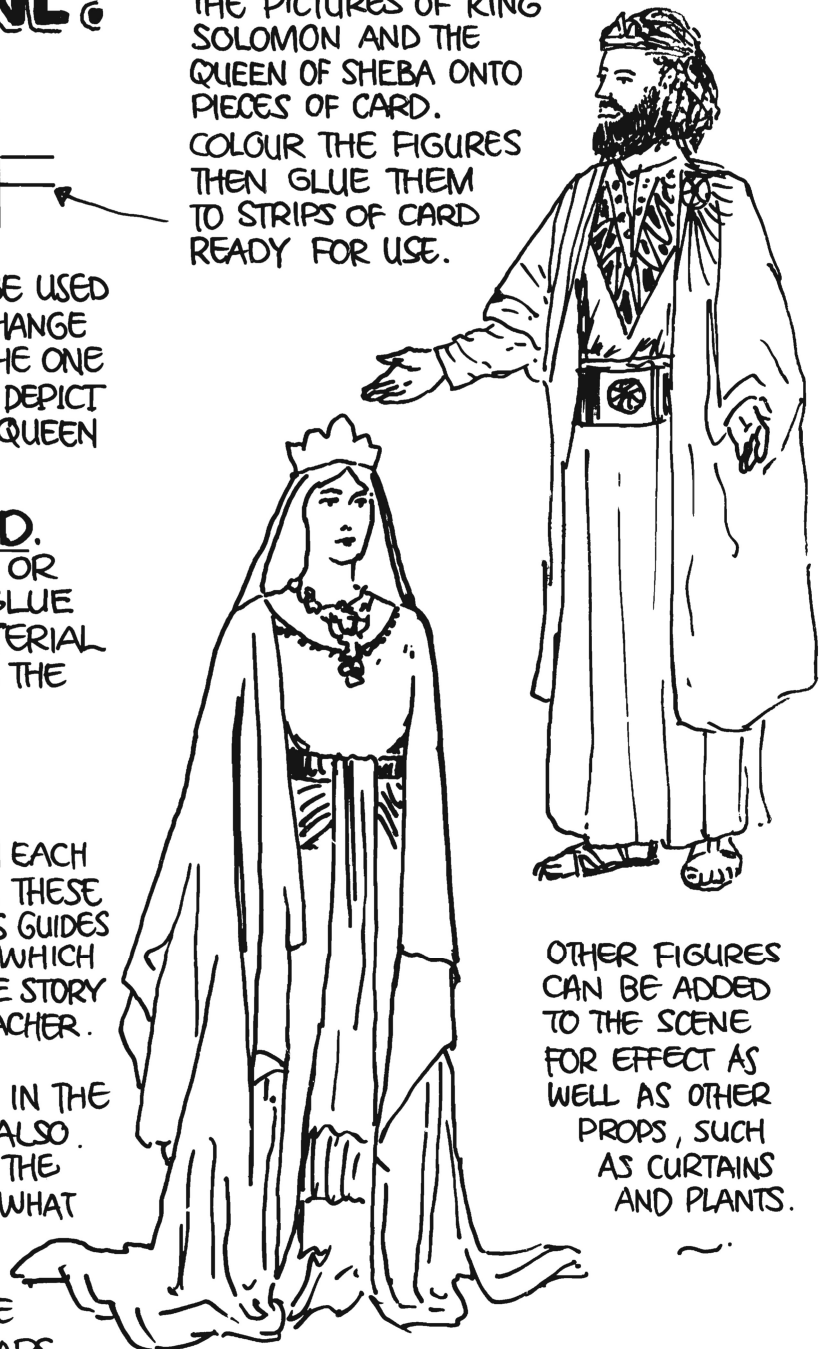


CUT TWO SLITS IN EACH SIDE OF THE BOX. THESE SLITS WILL ACT AS GUIDES FOR THE FIGURES, WHICH WILL ACT OUT THE STORY AS TOLD BY THE TEACHER.

CUT AN OPENING IN THE TOP OF THE BOX ALSO. THIS WILL ALLOW THE TEACHERS TO SEE WHAT THEY ARE DOING.

THE INSIDE OF THE BOX CAN BE DECORATED AS YOU WISH. PERHAPS WALLPAPER, MATERIAL OR A PARTICULAR SCENE CAN BE DRAWN OR PAINTED

COPY, TRACE OR PHOTOCOPY THE PICTURES OF KING SOLOMON AND THE QUEEN OF SHEBA ONTO PIECES OF CARD. COLOUR THE FIGURES THEN GLUE THEM TO STRIPS OF CARD READY FOR USE.



OTHER FIGURES CAN BE ADDED TO THE SCENE FOR EFFECT AS WELL AS OTHER PROPS, SUCH AS CURTAINS AND PLANTS.

CAMEL CARAVAN

CUT OUT CAMELS.



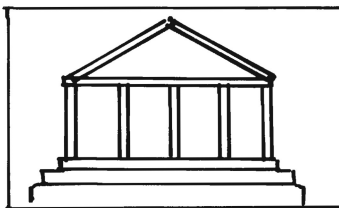
USING THE PATTERN ABOVE, HELP CHILDREN TO MAKE A CAMEL CARAVAN.

COPY ONTO WHITE CARD AND GIVE EACH SCHOLAR A CAMEL TO CUT OUT AND COLOUR IN. WHEN FINISHED EACH CHILD HANDS THE TEACHER THEIR 'CAMEL' WHICH IS THEN GLUED TO A PIECE OF PAPER TO FORM A 'CAMEL CARAVAN'. PIN ONTO WALL OF CLASS.

TO TAKE AWAY -
BRING ALONG THE SAME CUT OUT CAMEL - WITHOUT THE LEGS AND LET THE CHILDREN CLIP ON A FEW CLOTHES PEGS FOR LEGS.

WITH A PATTERN DRAWN ON A PIECE OF PAPER

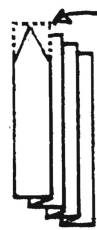
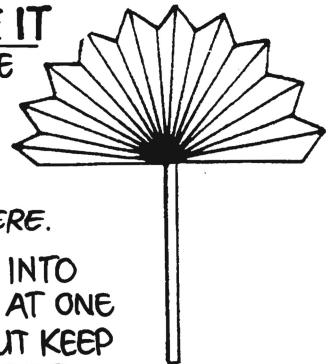

PAPER FAN

HOW TO MAKE IT

FOLD A 6" SQUARE PIECE OF PAPER INTO A CONCERTINA SHAPE



CUT HERE.

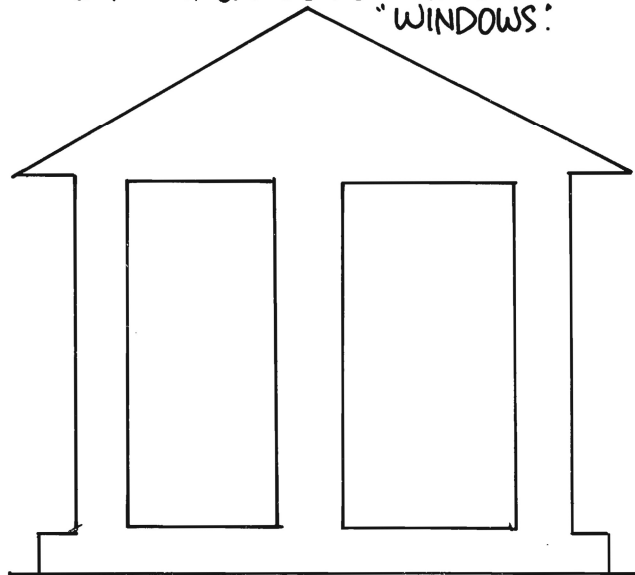
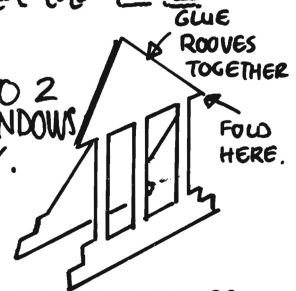
CUT IT INTO POINTS AT ONE END, BUT KEEP THE EDGES IN TACT. THEN OPEN OUT TO A FAN SHAPE, AND JOIN TO AN ICE-CREAM STICK OR SOMETHING SIMILAR.

CARD TEMPLE

COPY PATTERN OF TEMPLE BELOW ONTO 2 CARDS. CUT OUT WINDOWS IN THE TOP CARD ONLY.

GLUE THE 2 ROOF SECTIONS OF THE CARDS TOGETHER AND FOLD

TO STAND UP, AS IN DIAGRAM. PERHAPS WORDING CAN BE ADDED TO THE INSIDE CARD, SO IT CAN BE READ THROUGH THE 'WINDOWS'.

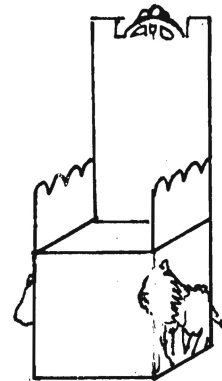
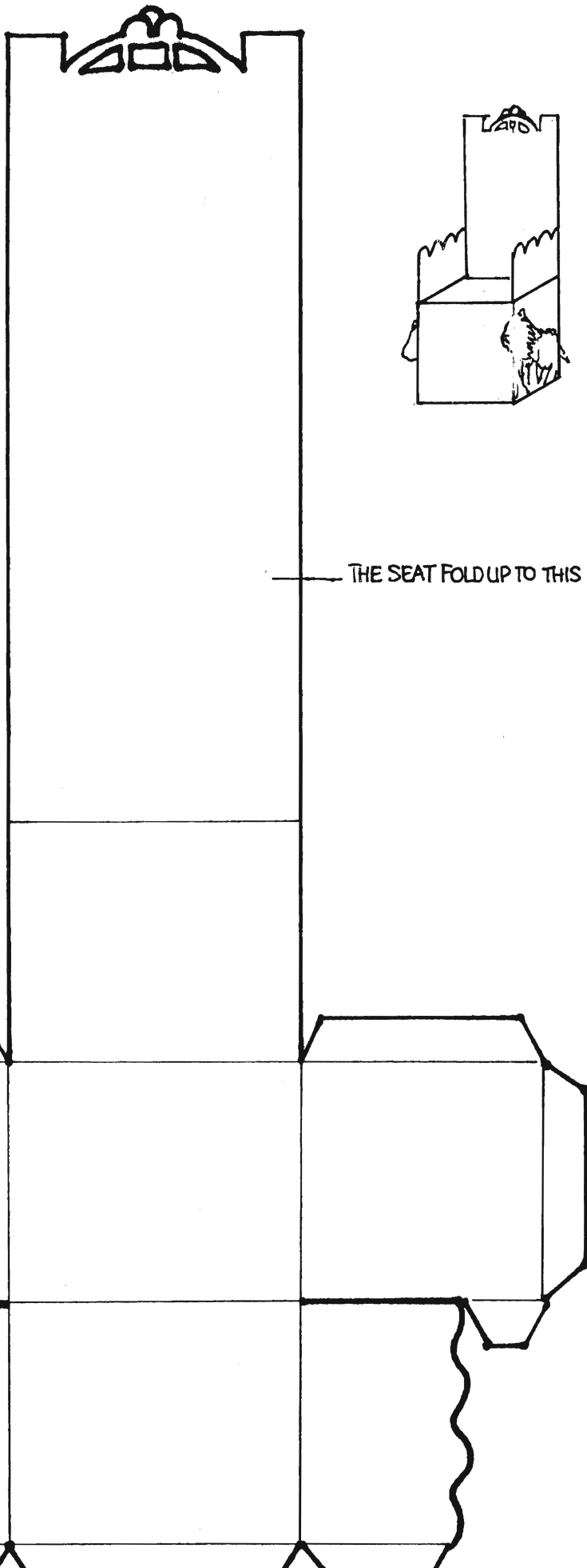
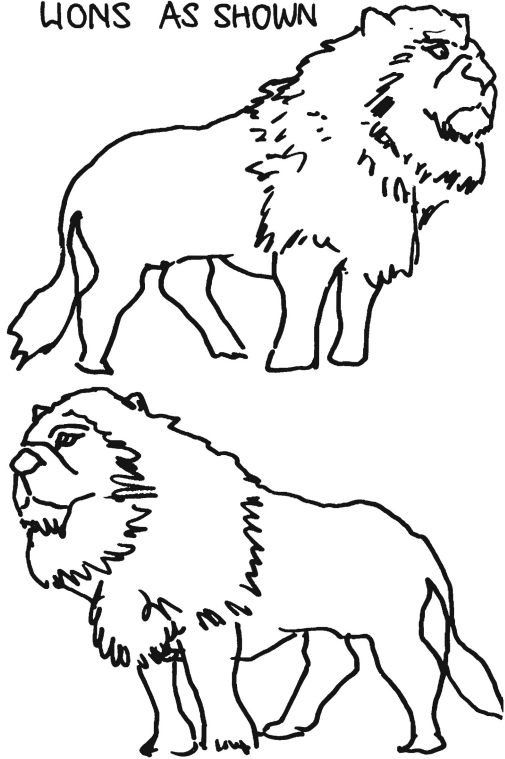


SOLOMONS THRONE.

USING GOLD COLOURED CARD OR PAPER, CUT OUT AND FOLD AS SHOWN IN THIS PATTERN.

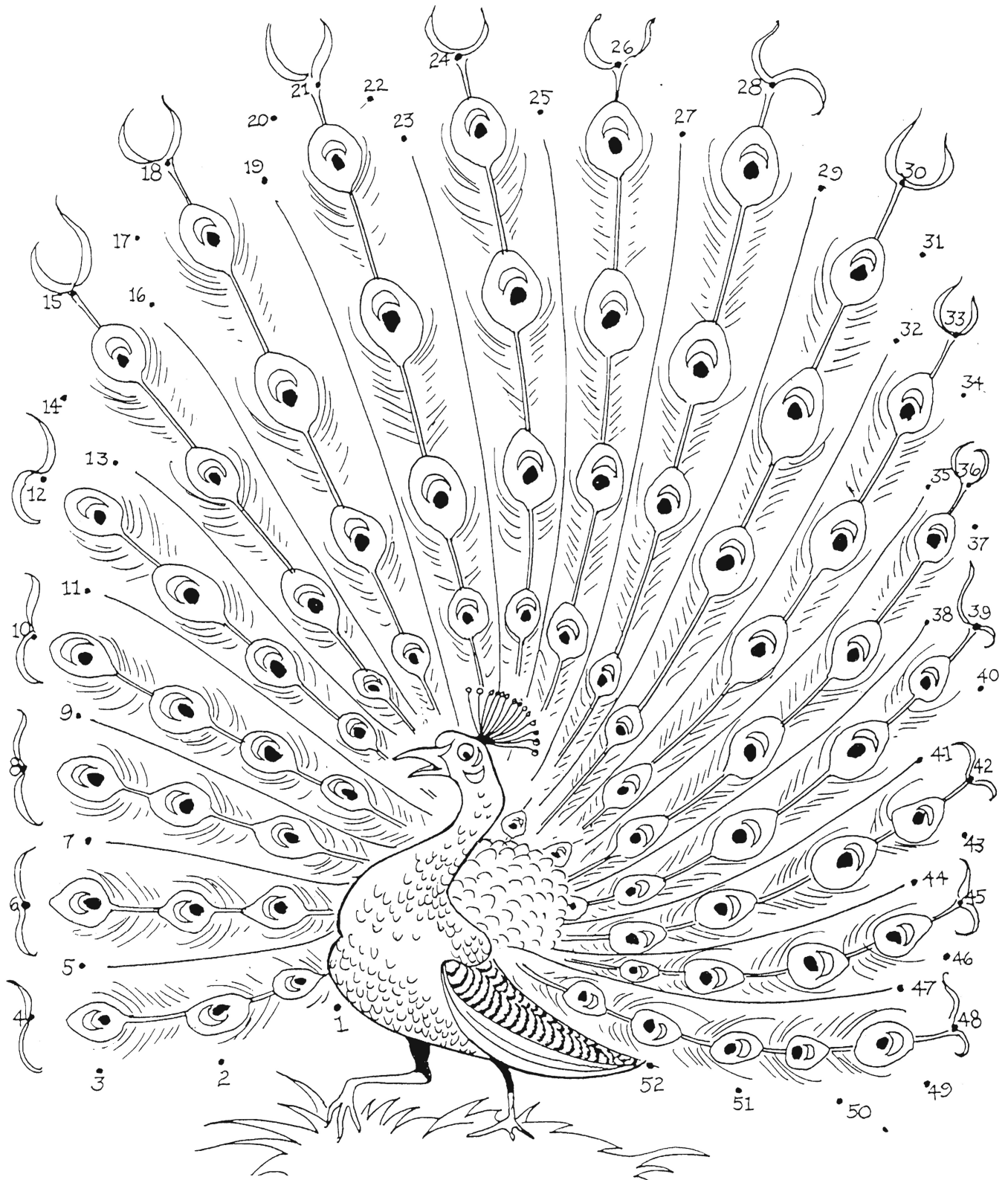
CUT ON THICK LINES. FOLD ON THIN LINES. GLUE FLAPS

CUT OUT AND GLUE ON LIONS AS SHOWN



THE SEAT FOLD UP TO THIS MARK.

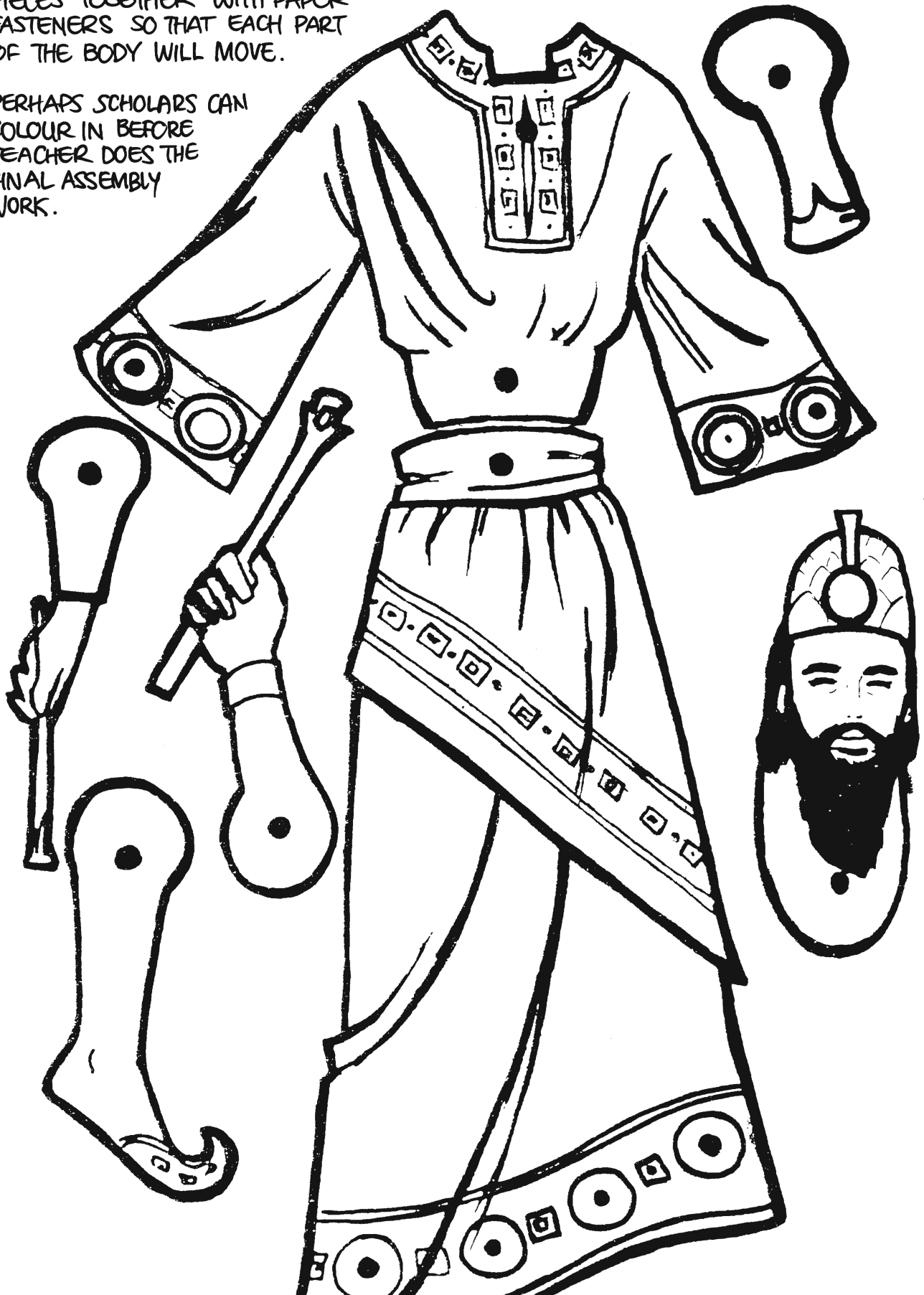
PHOTOCOOPY ~ CHILDREN TO JOIN THE DOTS AND COLOUR IN , PERHAPS
GLUING ON COLOURED SEQUINS IN APPROPRIATE PLACES.



A MOVING KING SOLOMON

COPY THE PATTERNS BELOW ONTO WHITE CARD. (CARBON PAPER IS HANDY FOR THIS PURPOSE). CUT OUT AND JOIN PIECES TOGETHER WITH PAPER FASTENERS SO THAT EACH PART OF THE BODY WILL MOVE.

PERHAPS SCHOLARS CAN COLOUR IN BEFORE TEACHER DOES THE FINAL ASSEMBLY WORK.



MAKING SOLOMONS TEMPLE.

THIS LITTLE PROJECT WILL IMPRESS ON SMALL MINDS HOW THE TEMPLE WAS BUILT.

CHILDREN TO COLOUR IN TREES AND ROCKS AND THEN CUT AND PASTE THEM ONTO THE OUTLINE OF THE TEMPLE BELOW.
