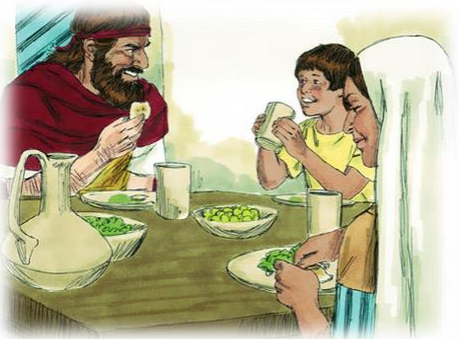


Lesson 5 – Elijah Raises the Widow’s Son

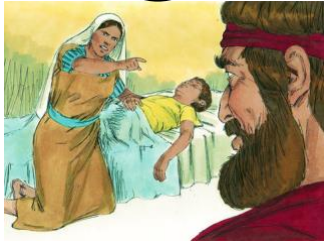
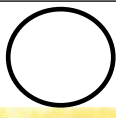
Then he stretched himself upon the child. He did this 3 times. He again turned to God in prayer and said, “O Yahweh my God I pray thee, let this child live again.”
