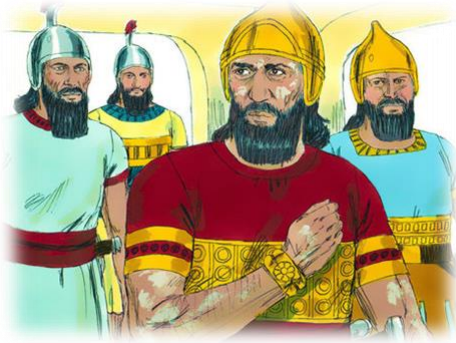


Lesson 11 – Naaman the Syrian

True or False? Circle the right answer

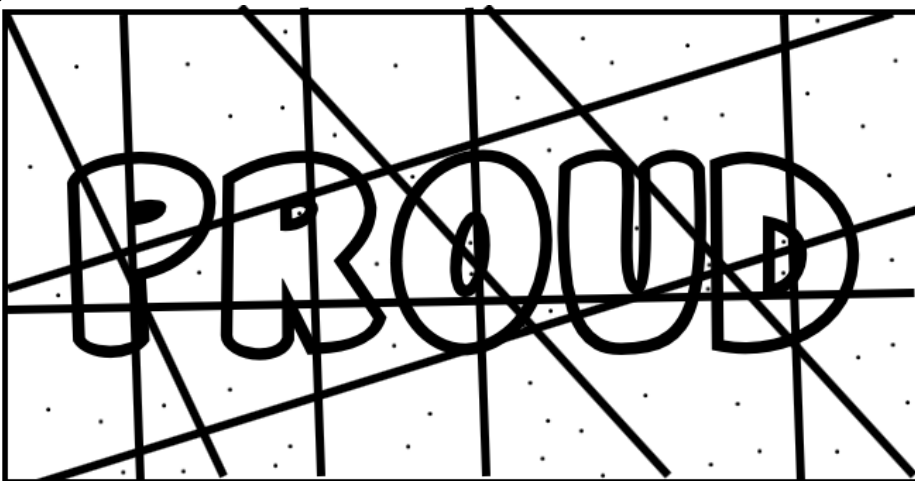
2. A little maid from Israel, who served Naaman's wife, knew where Naaman could go to be cured of his leprosy.

 - c) Go wash in the Jordan 7 times and your flesh will be healed and you will be clean.



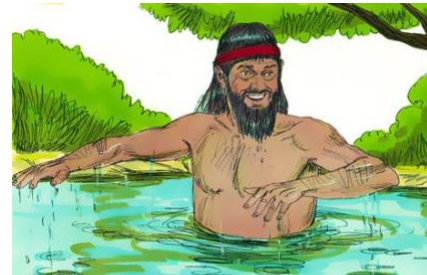
Colour Fun!
