Saddle (1 Kg. 13:11-15)	A seat for a rider on an animal

Bat (lev. 11:13-19)	A mammal that flies with leathery wings
Corner (2 Chron. 28:24)	The place where two street or roads meet
Save (Matt. 16:25)	To rescue from death
Crumb (Matt. 15:22-28)	A very, very small piece of food
Cub (Gen. 49:9)	A young lion
Angle (2 Chron. 26:9)	The figure formed by two lines meeting at a point
Wage (Isa. 19:10-12)	A payment for work done
Double (Prov. 5:1-4)	Something that is twice another
Guest (Lk. 19:7-10)	A person entertained in your house
Knock (Matt. 7:7)	To rap or hit with the knuckles, as on a door

Covet (Ex. 20:17)	To greatly want or envy what another has
Forget (Prov. 3:1-2)	To be unable to think of or recall
Fierce (2 Sam. 17:7-11)	Wild, threatening and likely to attack
Lamb (Isa. 65:23-25)	A young sheep
Soldier (2 Tim. 2:3-7)	A person who is in an army
Curtain (Matt. 27:46-52)	A piece of cloth or other material hung for decoration
Crack (Nahum 3:2)	The sudden sharp noise a whip makes
Disgrace (Matt. 1:19-20)	To bring shame to
Pact (Isa. 57:8)	An agreement or treaty
Gate (Matt. 7:13-14)	An opening in a wall or fence
Closed (Matt. 13:14-15)	Not open
Team (Isa. 21:6-9)	A group of animals who work or pull something together
