




Number the circles from 1 to 6 to put the story in the right order




The king made a decree that in every part of his kingdom people must tremble and fear the God of Daniel.




The king was not happy, but the law could not be changed. Daniel was taken and thrown into the den of lions.





Daniel heard about the new law, but he continued to pray to God three times a day with his window open toward Jerusalem.

When the other princes saw Daniel praying to his God, they hurried to tell the king that Daniel must be thrown to the lions.



