

Words/Phrases to look for:

- Mark key words and phrases directly in your Bible using colours or symbols. If you are using a different translation, they may be different words. When you mark them, ask the same 5 W's and an H.
- You may want to use colours topically, for example have a colour such as blue for God and things associated with Him - holiness, mercy, love, justice, etc. Another colour such as red for man and things related to him - sin, death, mortality. Then you can use the colour in various ways, such as underlining, boxing, circling, colouring in, or as symbols.

Other uses related to the whole chapter

- Look for lists perhaps related to a key word.
- Watch for contrasts and comparisons. 🍏 🍏
- Identify terms of conclusion such as *therefore*, *wherefore*, for this reason. When you see a *therefore*, note what it is there for!
- Look for bible echoes or interesting cross-references. 🏔️
- Look up any words you don't understand.
- Look for truths about God, humanity, the future, etc.
- Look for commands, instruction or wisdom.
- Ask questions and write them down. Then try to find the answers.
