MODEL DOVE



HOW TO MAKE IT.

- TRACE BODY OF BIRD ON LIGHTWEIGHT CARDBOARD
- TRACE WING AND TAIL ON FOLDED SHEETS OF COLOURED PAPER, KEEPING DOTTED LINES ON FOLD.
- CUT OUT AND COLOUR
- ATTACH WING AND TAIL TO BIRD BY INSERTING FOLD OF WING AND FOLD OF TAIL INTO CORRECT SLITS ON BIRD'S BODY. SEE COMPLETED SKETCH
- ATTACH LONG PIECE OF THREAD TO BIRD.



SURPRISE WINDOW

MATERIALS REQUIRED.

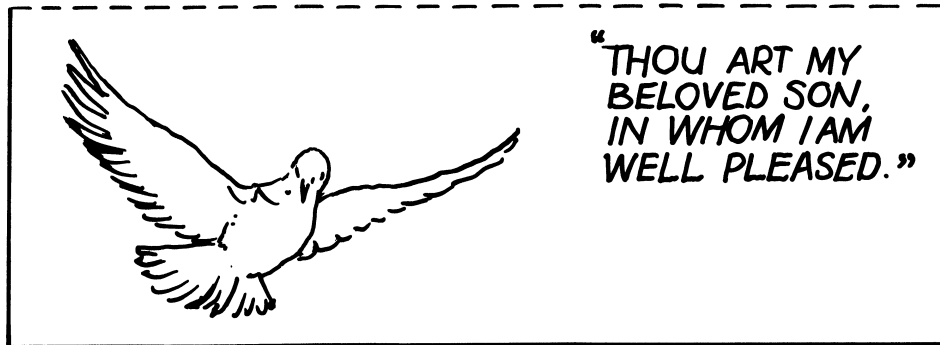
● 2 PIECES OF CARD APPROX. 20 cm X 17 cm ● GLUE ● SCISSORS OR SHARP CRAFT KNIFE. ● PICTURE PROVIDED ON THIS PAGE.

HOW TO MAKE IT.

COPY PICTURE BELOW ON TO TOP CARD, COPY BOX BUT NOT DOVE OR WRITING. CUT ON LINES, FOLD ON DOTTED LINE. THIS WILL OPEN OUT TO FORM WINDOW.

ON THE BOTTOM SHEET JUST COPY THE DOVE AND THE WORDING. MAKE SURE IT IS IN THE SAME POSITION IN RELATION TO THE TWO FIGURES AS IN THE TOP SHEET. GLUE THE TWO SHEETS TOGETHER. BE CAREFUL NOT TO GLUE DOWN THE WINDOW.

THE WINDOW SHOULD NOW OPEN TO REVEAL THE DOVE AND WORDS FROM HEAVEN.



BAPTISM MODEL

MATERIALS REQUIRED.

- A4 PIECE OF CARD
- GLUE
- CRAFT KNIFE OR SCISSORS

HOW TO MAKE IT.

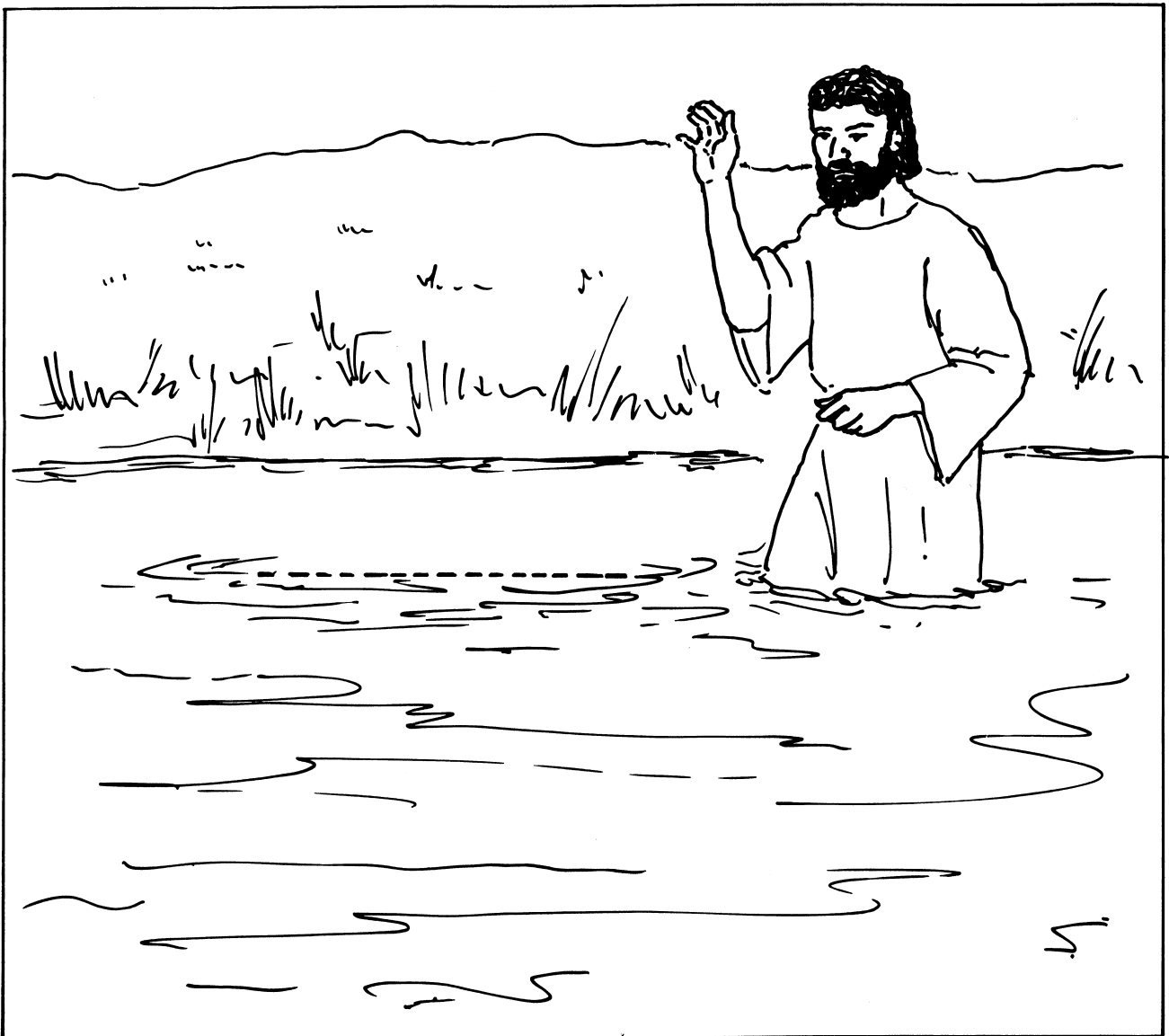
COPY PICTURE BELOW ONTO CARD AND CUT TO SIZE. MAKE A SLIT IN CARD ON THE DOTTED LINE. COPY AND CUT OUT SEPARATE FIGURE AND GLUE ON A TAB ON THE REVERSE SIDE AS SHOWN IN DIAGRAM (A) PERHAPS CHILDREN CAN COLOUR IN THE PICTURES TO FINISH THE MODEL OFF.

COPY PICTURE ON PAGE 5. COLOUR IN, CUT OUT ON SOLID LINES, FOLD AS INDICATED. UNFOLD PICTURE AS LESSON IS TAUGHT.

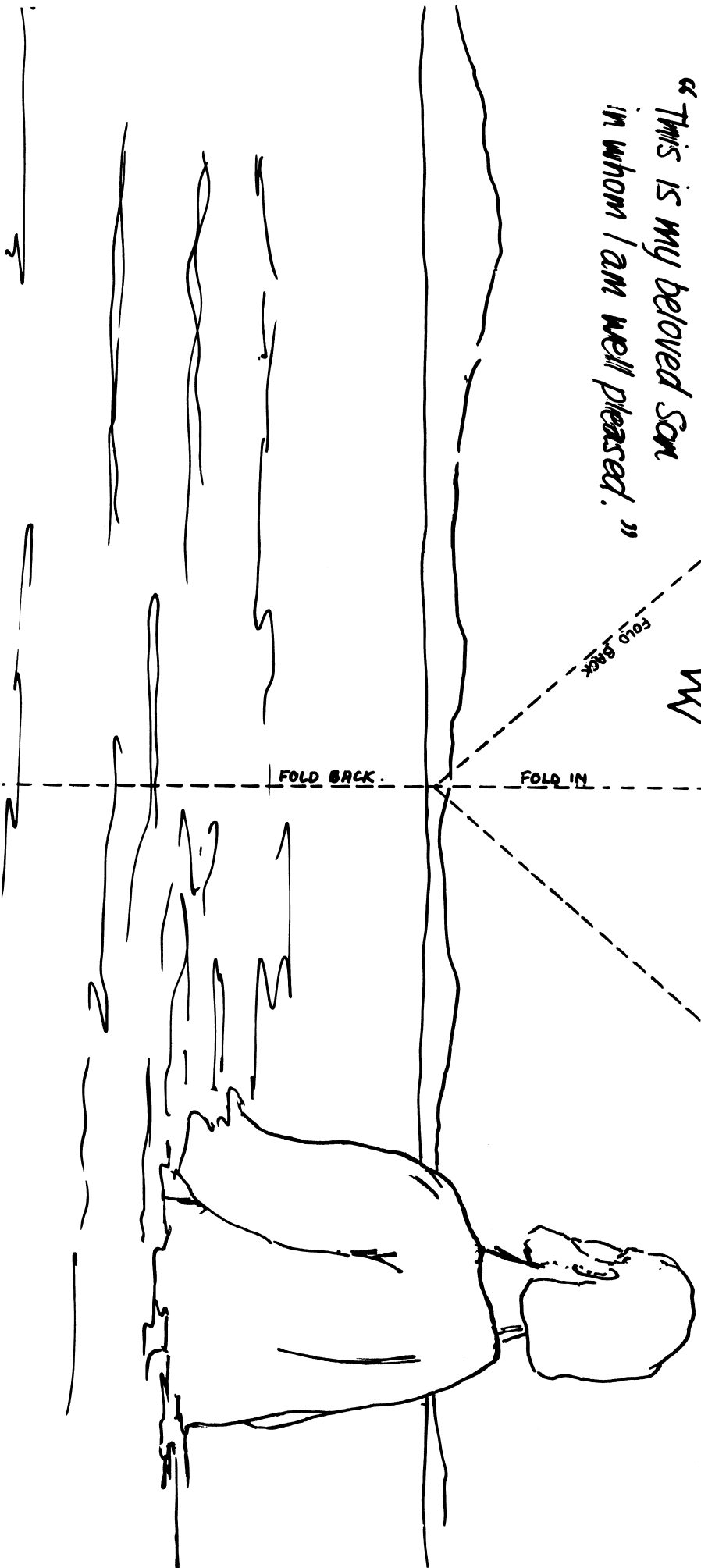
