


# The Five Friends

## MODEL HOUSE.


THE FOLLOWING EXAMPLES OF HOUSES MADE FROM BOXES WILL PROVE TO BE USEFUL FOR MANY A FUTURE LESSON.




### MATERIALS REQUIRED.

CARDBOARD BOX ANY REASONABLE SIZE ● SHARD CRAFT KNIFE ● WHITE PAINT (CEILING PAINT OR SIMILAR MATT FINISH WHITE) ● SAW DUST.

### HOW TO MAKE IT.




CUT THE TOP FLAPS OFF THE BOX AND USE THEM BY CUTTING INTO STRIPS, BENDING IN HALF AND GLUEING THEM ONTO THE INSIDE OF BOX TO USE AS A BASE FOR THE REMOVABLE ROOF.




STAIRS


CUT FROM A BLOCK OF Balsa WOOD. GLUE ONTO THE SIDE OF THE BOX.



DOOR LINTEL MAKE FROM STRIP OF CARDBOARD FROM BOX.



DOOR - CUT OUT ALONG LINES AND FOLD BACK ALONG DOTTED LINES TO GIVE THE LOOK OF A THICK WALL.  
WINDOW ~ CUT OUT SQUARE WITH SHARP KNIFE.



TO GIVE THE 'HOUSE' A WHITEWASHED PLASTER LOOK, PAINT ON A MIXTURE OF WHITE PAINT AND SAWDUST. IF YOU ARE REALLY AMBITIOUS, TRY APPLYING A THICK CREAMY MIXTURE OF PLASTER INSTEAD.


### CLASS ACTIVITY.


## ROLL UP BED

### HOW TO MAKE IT.


CUT A PIECE OF PAPER OR MATERIAL TO ABOUT 260mm x 75mm. CUT OUT A MAN, AS EXAMPLE, FROM STIFF CARD. TO PUT HIM IN BED, DIVIDE PAPER INTO THIRDS. ROLL UP ONE THIRD FOR THE PILLOW AND FOLD THE OTHER END THIRD FOR THE SHEET AND PUT THE MAN TO BED AS SHOWN IN DIAGRAM. HE CAN THEN BE TAKEN OUT OF BED, ROLL UP THE BED AND TUCK IT UNDER HIS ARM READY TO 'GO HOME'.




### A PIPECLEANER MAN WITH A 'LIFESAVER' BED.



MAKE PIPECLEANER FIGURE AS SHOWN BELOW. TAPE OR GLUE A PACKET OF 'LIFESAVERS' UNDER HIS ARM. PERHAPS THE PACKET OF 'LIFESAVERS' COULD BE COVERED WITH MATERIAL TO MAKE IT LOOK LIKE A MATTRESS. THE MAN TAKES UP HIS BED AND WALKS - CHILDREN TAKE HOME AND EAT!
