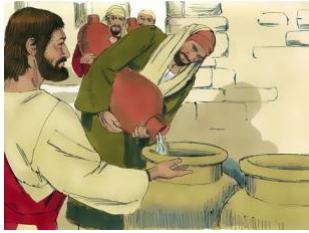
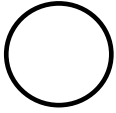

## What Happened First?

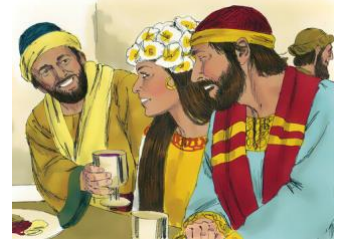
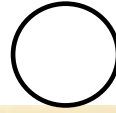
Number the circles from 1 to 5 to put the story in the right order



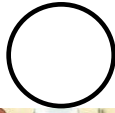
Jesus told the servants to "Fill the waterpots with water" So they filled them to the brim.



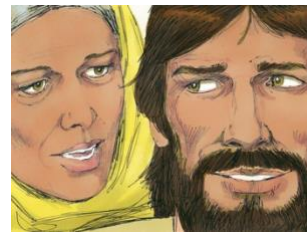
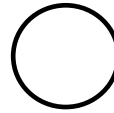
Jesus and his disciples were invited to a wedding in Cana. His mother Mary was there too.
