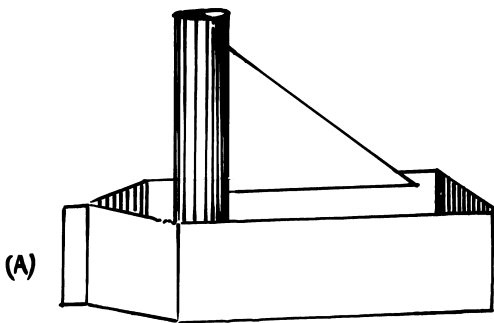


Jesus Stills the Storm

BOAT MODEL .



MATERIALS REQUIRED.

- MILK CARTON (EMPTY!)
- GLUE
- CARDBOARD ROLL
- SMALL PIECE OF WHITE CARD FOR THE SAIL.
- SCISSORS
- PAINT.

HOW TO MAKE IT.

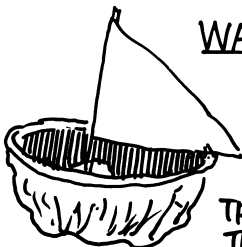
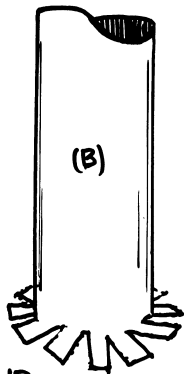
CUT THE SIDE OFF A USED MILK CARTON AS SHOWN IN DIAGRAM (A).

CUT 1 cm. LONG SLITS AT ONE END OF THE CARDBOARD ROLL AND BEND THE FLAPS OUTWARD AS SHOWN IN DIAGRAM (B).

GLUE THE UNDERNEATH OF THE FLAPS AND STICK TO THE INSIDE OF THE BOAT. DIAGRAM (A).

CUT OUT A TRIANGLE OF WHITE CARD AND GLUE ONTO THE 'MAST'.

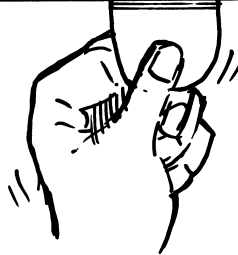
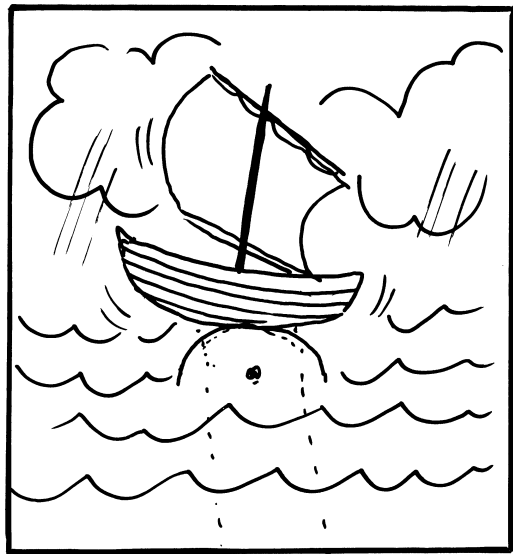
TO FINISH OFF THE BOAT, PAINT IT A COLOUR OF YOUR CHOICE.



WALNUT SHELL BOAT.

USE TOOTHPICK FOR A MAST, STICK ON WITH BLUE-TAC. GLUE PAPER TRIANGLE TO MAST FOR THE SAIL.

ROCKING BOAT.

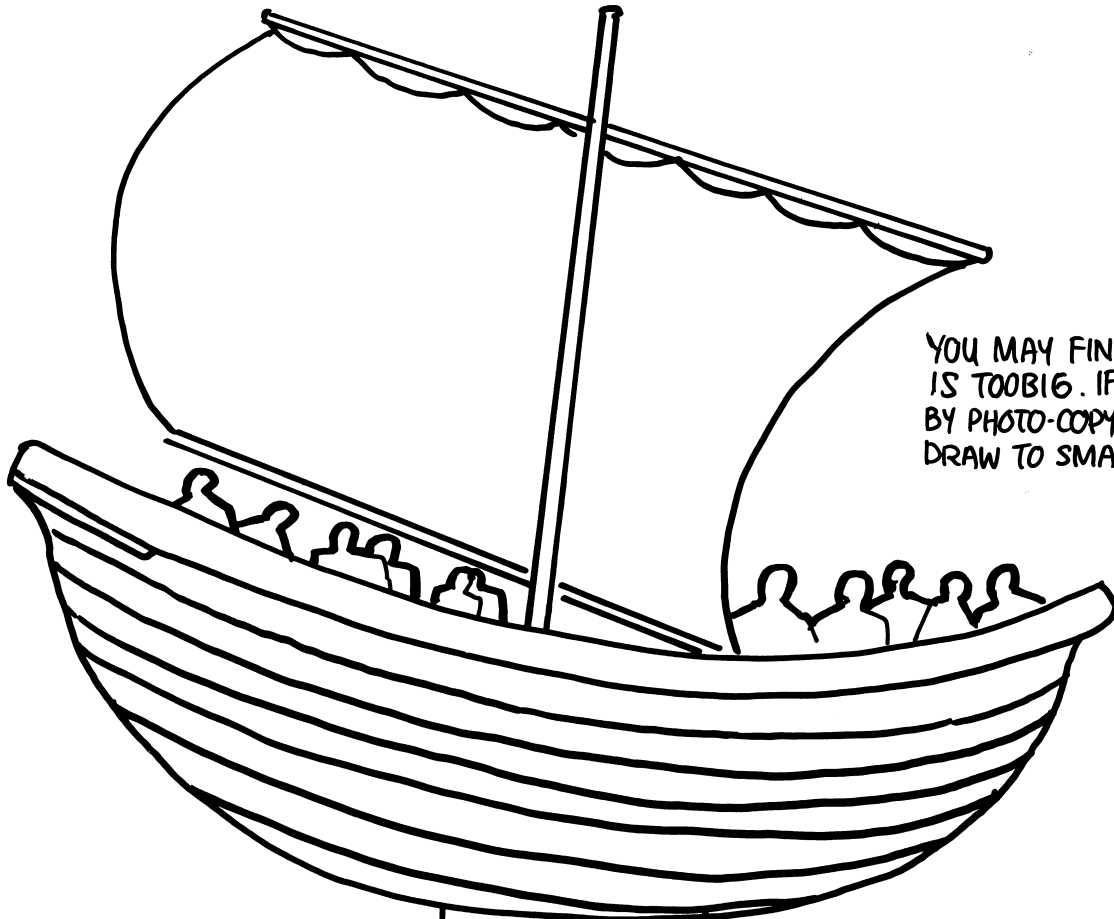


MATERIALS REQUIRED.

- CARDBOARD
- SCISSORS
- PAPER FASTENER
- BLUE CELLOPHANE OR PAPER.

HOW TO MAKE IT.

PHOTOCOPY OR COPY THE PICTURE OF THE SHIP ON THE NEXT PAGE. ONTO A PIECE OF CARD. ON ANOTHER PIECE OF CARD OR PAPER, PAINT, DRAW OR GLUE COLOURED PAPER OR CELLOPHANE TO DEPICT THE SEA. PUNCH A HOLE IN THE MIDDLE OF THE SEA AND SLIT AN ARC A FEW CENTIMETRES ABOVE HOLE AS IN DIAGRAM. PUSH PAPER FASTENER THROUGH HOLE IN TAB ON THE BOAT AND THE MAIN SHEET. ROCK THE BOAT AS ABOVE DIAGRAM SHOWS.



YOU MAY FIND THIS BOAT IS TOO BIG. IF SO REDUCE BY PHOTO-COPY OR RE-DRAW TO SMALLER SIZE.

BADGE
