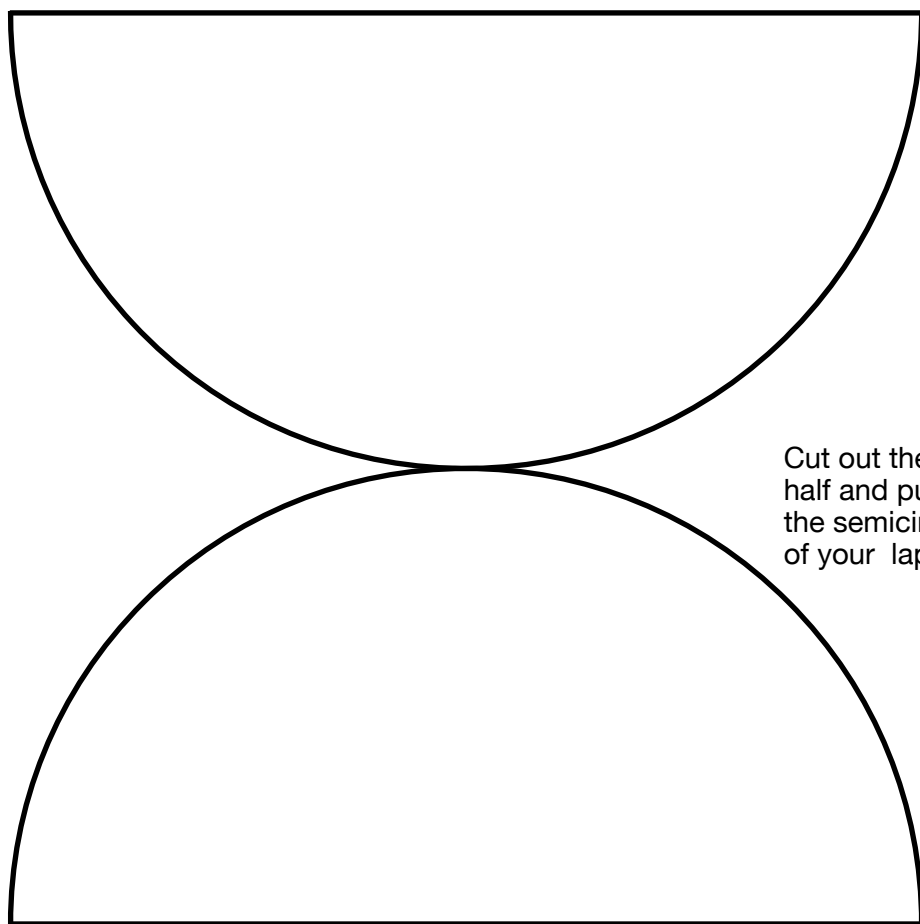
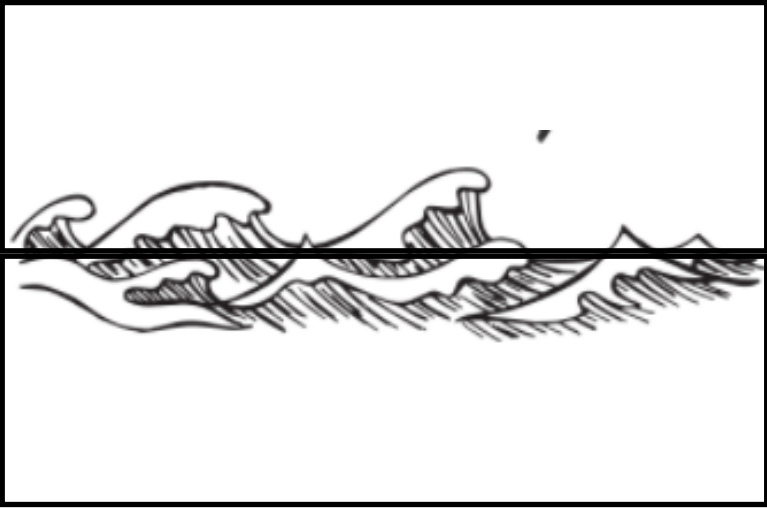


Cut out both circles of the decoder, lay the smaller circle on the larger circle and fasten with a brad. Cut out the little window so you can see the letter. **You will need the decoder for other lessons.** (It can be printed in black and white or colour). Best if printed on card stock. Decoder from: [upliftingmayhem.com](http://upliftingmayhem.com)

Glue the decoder to the back of your lap book for storage.



Cut out the decoder holder without cutting it in half. Fold in half and put a small line of glue around the outside edge of the semicircle to create a pocket. Glue onto the back cover of your lap book and store the decoder inside.

Cut out the 2 rectangles. Cut the smaller rectangle in half through the waves. Fold the flaps on the larger rectangle so that the coded message is covered. Glue the rectangles with the waves on the outside of the flaps. Decode the message using the decoder and glue into the lap book.



Cut out the circle and the picture (cutting close to the boat and the characters but along the lines of the waves).

Place the circle behind the picture and fasten them together with a brad. Glue only the space that the circle does not touch the image into the lap book (so that the circle can spin and change from storm to calm).
