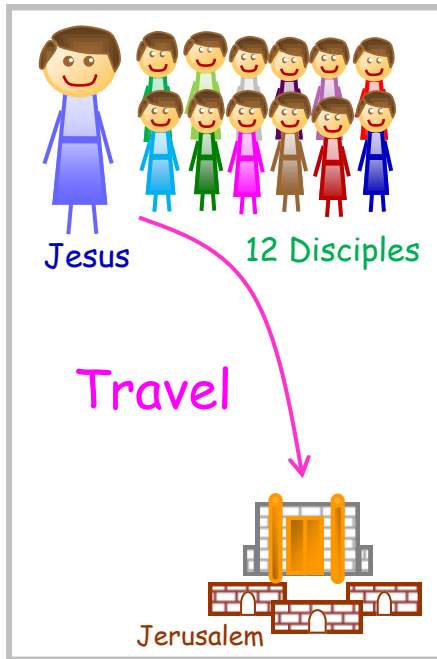
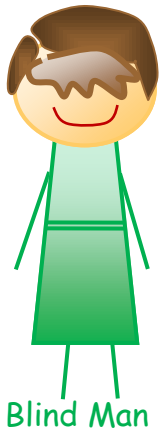
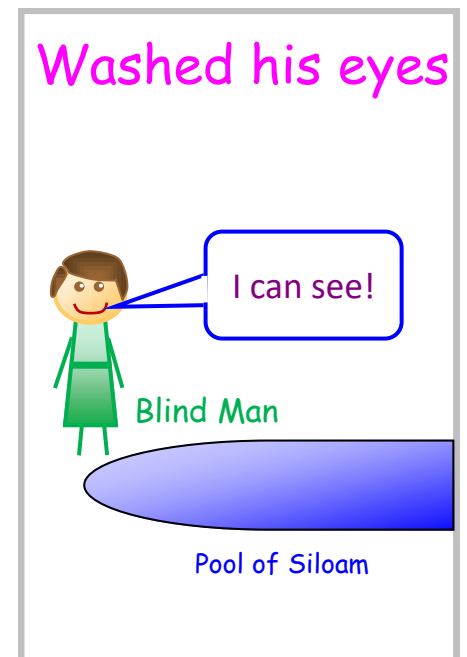
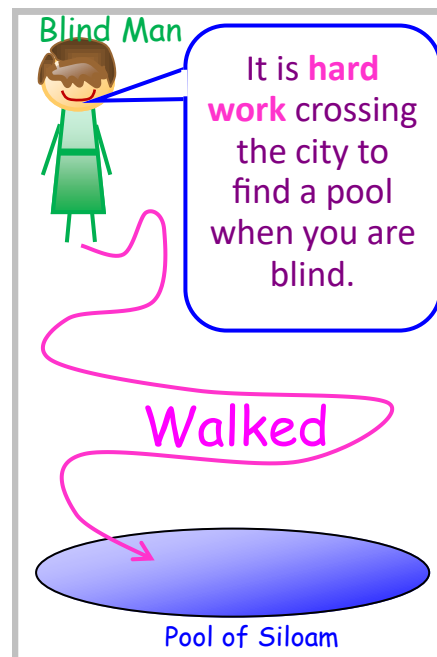
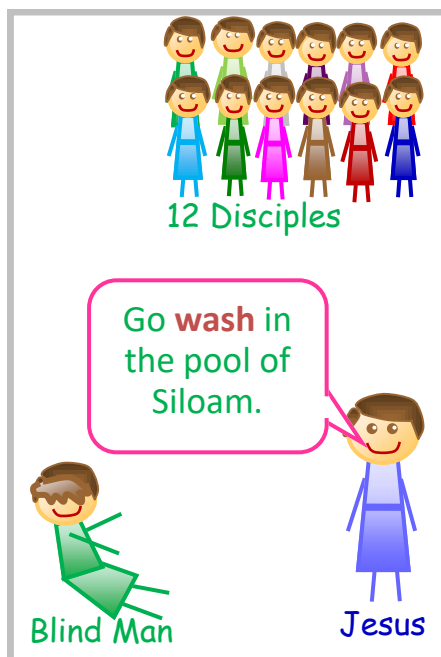
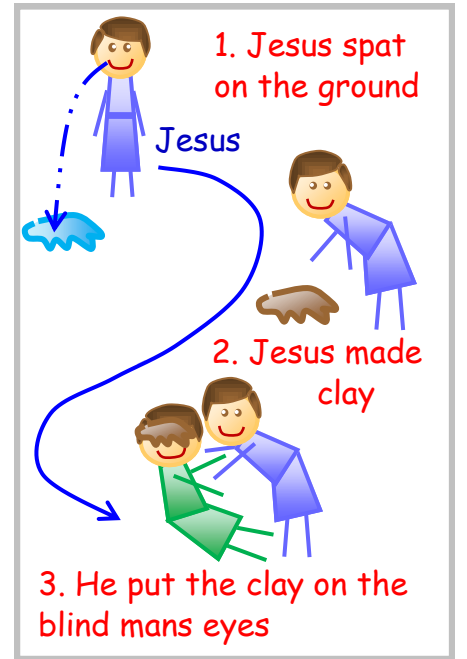
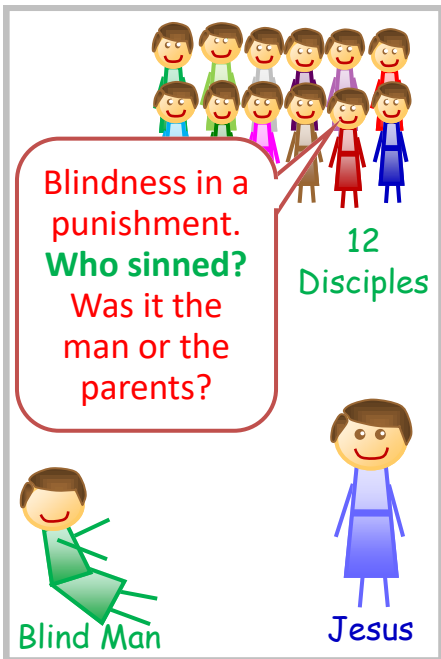
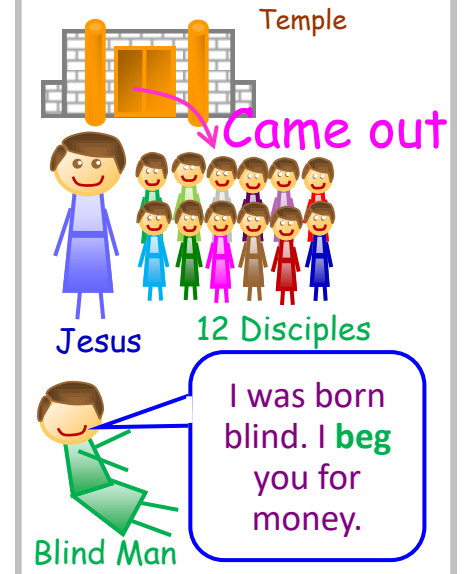


14 - The Blind Man at Siloam
