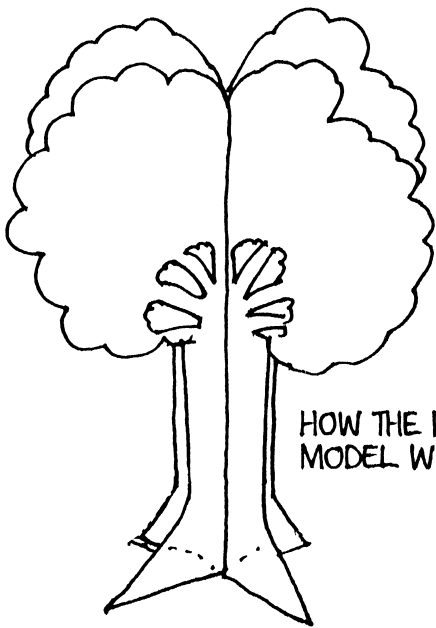
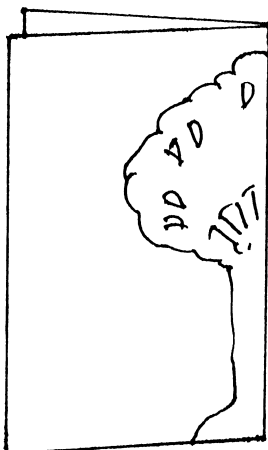


Zacchaeus

STAND UP TREE



HOW THE FINISHED MODEL WILL LOOK.



MATERIALS REQUIRED.

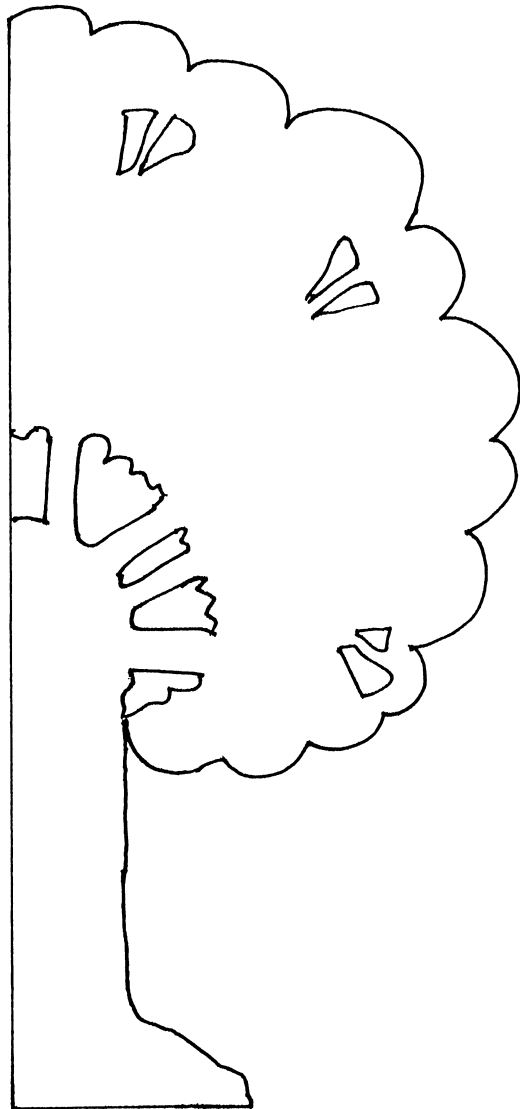
A PIECE OF CARD (x2)
150 mm x 140 mm.

● SCISSORS OR SHARP KNIFE ●

HOW TO MAKE IT.

FOLD CARD IN HALF AND DRAW HALF A TREE. USE THE TREE OPPOSITE AS A TEMPLATE. CUT OUT THE TREE WITH THE CARD STILL FOLDED.

REPEAT WITH THE OTHER PIECE OF CARD. SLIT ONE OF THE TREES FROM THE TOP TO ABOUT HALF WAY DOWN AND THE OTHER FROM THE BOTTOM TO HALF WAY UP. SLIDE THEM TOGETHER WITH THE TWO TREES PERPENDICULAR TO EACH OTHER AND STAND UP THE TREE.

FUN WITH LEAVES

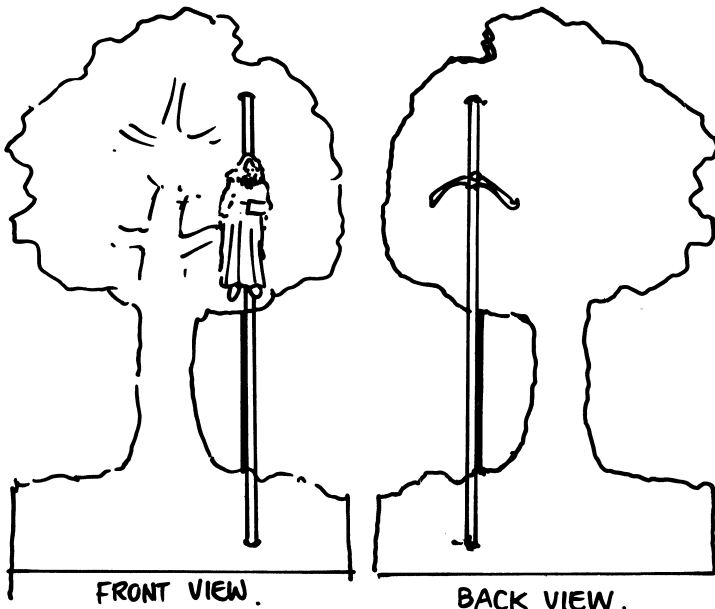
USING THE TREE PATTERN ON THE NEXT PAGE, TRY SOME OF THESE IDEAS IN CLASS.

- GLUE ON DRIED OR PRESSED LEAVES.
- DRAW OR PAINT LEAVES ON THE TREE.
- USE REAL LEAVES TO MAKE PRINT
 - * COVER ONE SIDE OF LEAF WITH GLUE.
 - * PRESS DOWN ON PAPER.
 - * LIFT OFF AND SPRINKLE GLITTER OVER GLUE PRINT.

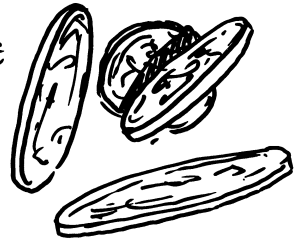
MOVING MODEL



USING THE TREE PATTERN ON THE NEXT PAGE, COPY ONTO A STIFF PIECE OF CARD. MAKE TWO HOLES, ONE NEAR THE TOP OF THE TREE AND ONE AT THE BASE. THREAD A LENGTH OF WOOL OR STRING THROUGH THE HOLES AND TIE AT THE BACK AS SHOWN BELOW. CUT OUT THE FIGURE OPPOSITE AND GLUE OR TAPE TO THE WOOL AT THE FRONT OF THE TREE.



CHILDREN COULD BE GIVEN CHOCOLATE 'COINS' TO TAKE HOME. CHOCOLATE MONEY MOLDS ARE USUALLY AVAILABLE.



SOME MORE IDEAS

SOME SUNDAY SCHOOLS HAVE TREES ON THE GROUNDS OR SOMEWHERE CLOSE BY.

BY PRIOR ARRANGEMENT, AN OLDER SCHOLAR OR UNCLE CAN DRESS UP 'BIBLE COSTUME STYLE' AND CLIMB UP ONTO A 'LOW' BRANCH ON THE TREE. YOUNGER SCHOLARS ARE THEN LED OUT AT SOME PRE-ARRANGED TIME DURING THE LESSON TO SEE 'ZACHAEUS' FIRST HAND. A LESSON THEY WON'T FORGET.

- A DEMONSTRATION OF THIS LESSON CAN BE HAD BY USING A SMALL BOUGH OF A TREE AND A DOLL WHICH HAS BEEN SUITABLY DRESSED.
