




Get to know a butterfly

The Common Wood Nymph

Family: Nymphalidae Sub-Family: Nymphalinae Latin name: Cercyonis pegala



The female butterfly lays her pale yellow eggs in late summer on the leaves of grasses. About three weeks later, the eggs hatch into tiny green caterpillars. Instead of eating, they burrow into the grass clump and begin hibernating.

In the spring, when the weather warms up and the grass is growing again, the caterpillars wake up and start eating, grow slowly. Around June they change to a pale green chrysalis and emerge as butterflies in July and August.

The butterflies feed on the nectar from various flowers as well as carrion and dung, not laying their eggs until the weather begins to cool down. They are common along streams and the borders of forests as well as meadows.

"Looking at these four sturdy, sincere men, each different yet having in common the desire to follow him without counting the cost, Jesus was under no illusion about the difficulty of the task he had set himself. But because he had implicit faith in his Father's guidance, and recognized in these men his Father's gift to him, he was able to say confidently, 'I will make you...' Many weary months of misunderstanding and doubt lay between them and their complete transformation, but by love and understanding, sympathy and rebuke, their education was to be developed until the day when they were to continue his work in the earth, worthily reflecting the glory which shone forth from him. Even now their calling was not complete. It was for three of them the third stage in their spiritual relationship with their Lord. Now they were called to discipleship; soon their vocation would be apostleship."

"His discourse over, Jesus turned his attention once more to the men who had so eagerly obeyed his call. He was anxious to show them in a way which they would never forget, that he had asked them to revoke their lower calling for a higher one. They were to be fishermen still, but their work was no longer to be limited to the waters of the lake, and the darting silver forms which struggled in their nets. The whole world was to be their fishing ground, and the seething crowds now reluctantly dispersing on the shore were to be enclosed in their net. So the first great lesson of their discipleship began, 'Launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a draught'."

"Soon both ships were so laden with fish that they were in danger of sinking. Peter worked feverishly, his mind completely bewildered by the experience. He had seen Jesus perform miracles before, miracles that many would believe were far greater than this, but he had seen nothing that touched him so closely. He needed nothing more to convince him that he was in the presence of the Messiah."

"Luke tells us that as soon as they brought their ships to land, they forsook all and followed him."
