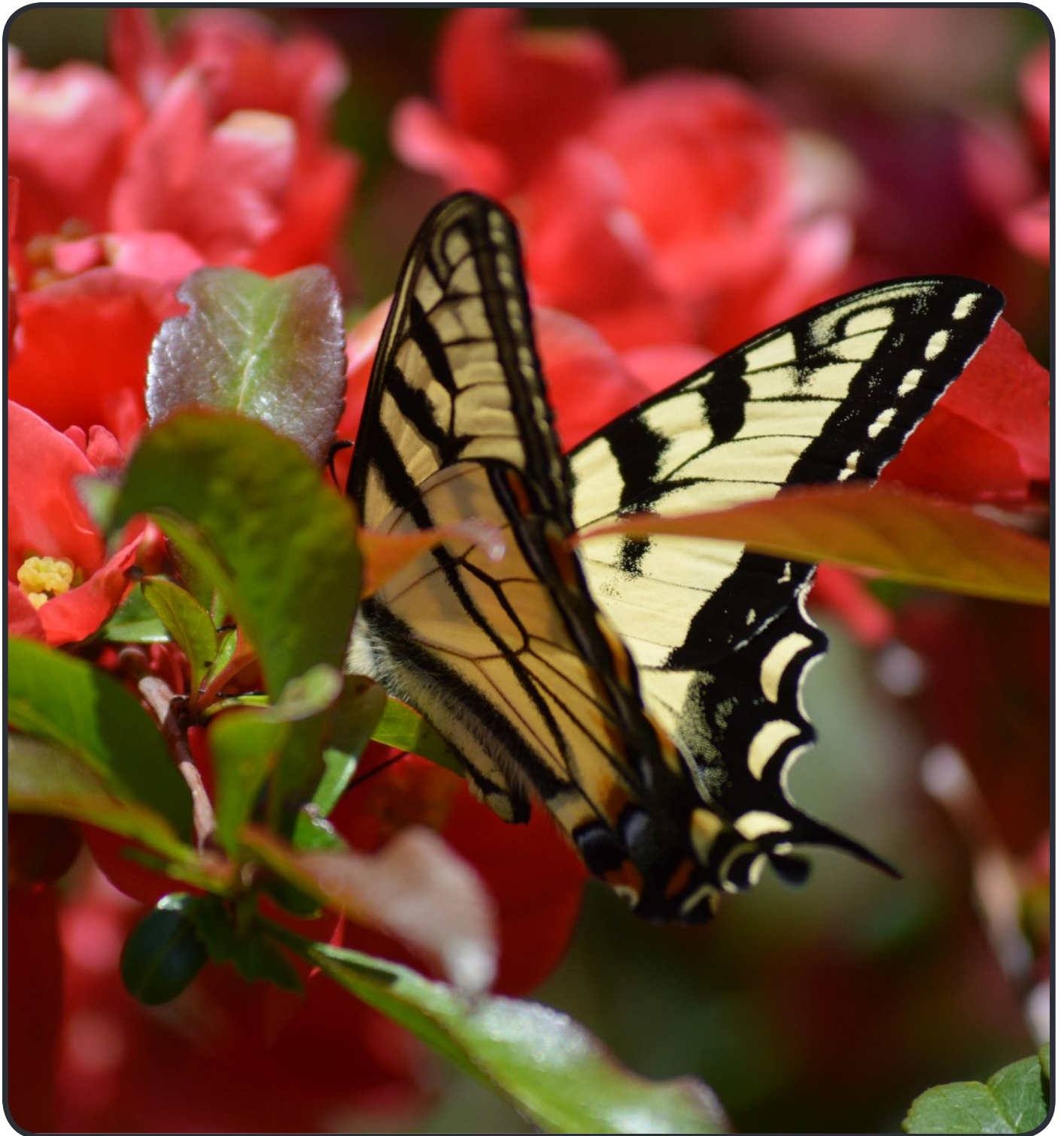
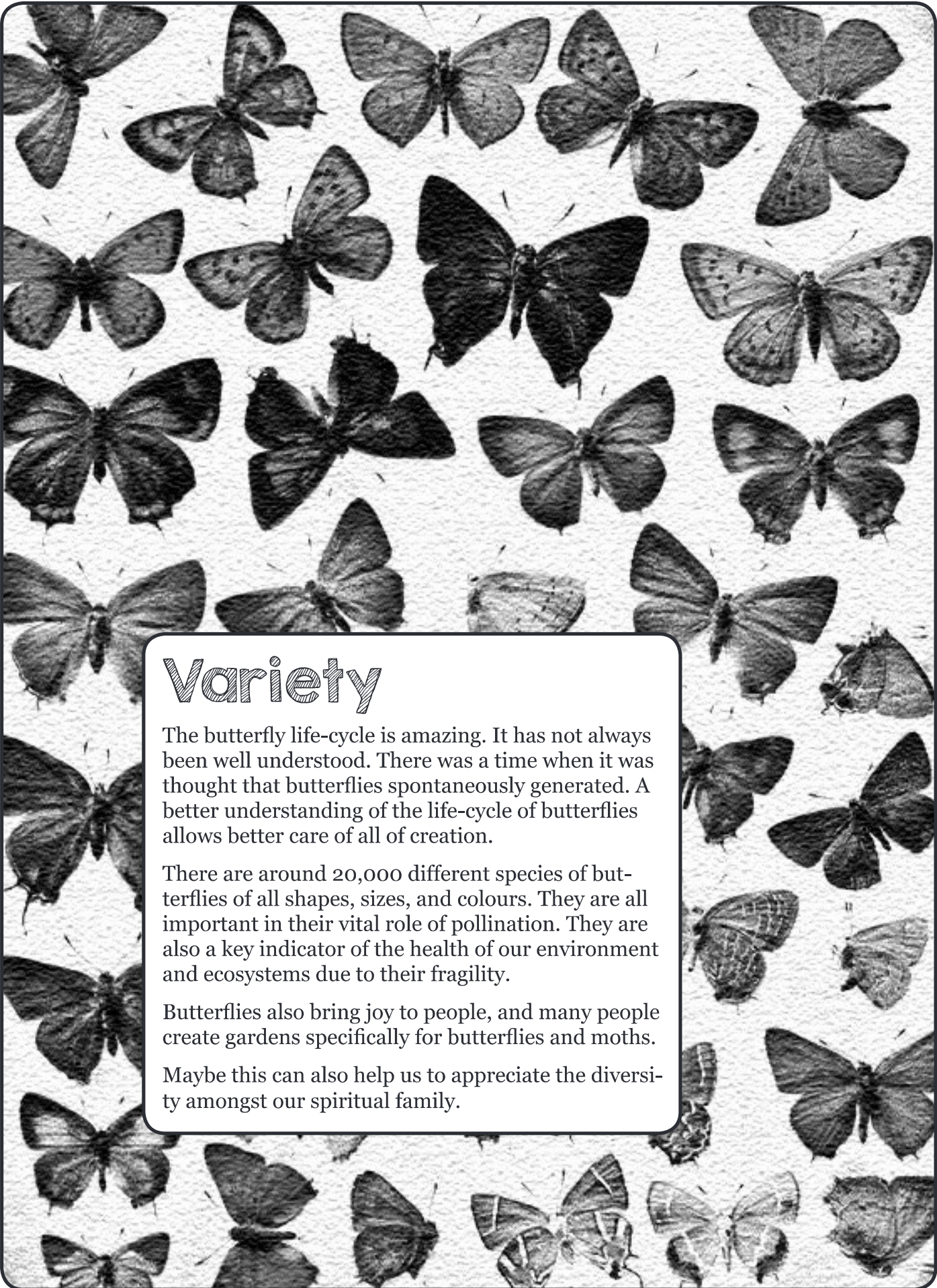

# Get to know a butterfly

## The Great Spangled Fritillary

Family: *Nymphalidae*

Sub-Family: *Heliconiinae*

Latin Name: *Argynnis cybele*



The fritillary butterflies are one you may see most often during the summer. The name comes from the Latin word “fritillus” which means “chessboard”. They like open spaces like fields, meadows, marshy woodlands, and prairies. They fly throughout the summer, stopping to lay their eggs in the late summer. These eggs are laid on the leaves and stems of the wild violet and then the mother dies.

The caterpillars hatch, but eat nothing, instead hibernating in the leaf litter for the winter. In the spring they wake up and feed at night mostly on the violet plants, hiding during the day in the leaf litter. The caterpillars are black with orange bumps and black spines.

In June they become a dark brown chrysalis and emerge as butterflies 14 to 24 days later. The butterflies feed on nectar rich wildflowers like milkweed, verbena, butterfly bush, purple coneflower, and bee balm.
