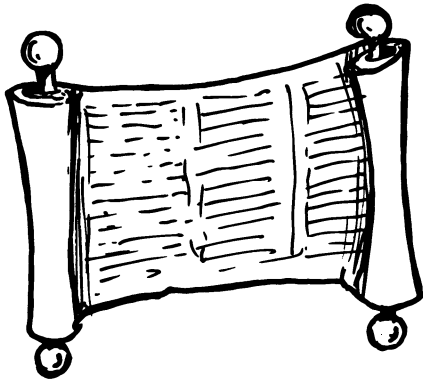


Philip Baptises a Eunuch from Ethiopia

SCROLL



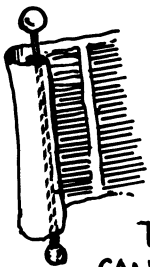
MATERIALS REQUIRED.

A PIECE OF DOWEL ● WOODEN BEADS TO FIT THE DOWEL ● GLUE

HOW TO MAKE IT.

THE SCROLL CAN BE MADE TO ANY HEIGHT OR WIDTH. TO MAKE IT VERY REALISTIC, PHOTOCOPY ISA.53 AND THE CHAPTERS BEFORE AND AFTER.

GLUE TWO OR THREE PAGES TOGETHER IN A LINE AS SHOWN HERE.



GLUE BEADS TO DOWEL WHICH HAS BEEN CUT TO A SUITABLE LENGTH. SPREAD GLUE ON THE DOWELING AT EACH END AND ROLL ON THE 'MANUSCRIPT'.

THE OUTSIDE OF THE PAPER CAN BE DECORATED IF DESIRED. BEFORE THE SCROLL IS ASSEMBLED.

FOLD OUT CARD



PHOTOCOPY OR TRACE THE CARD ON PAGE 22.

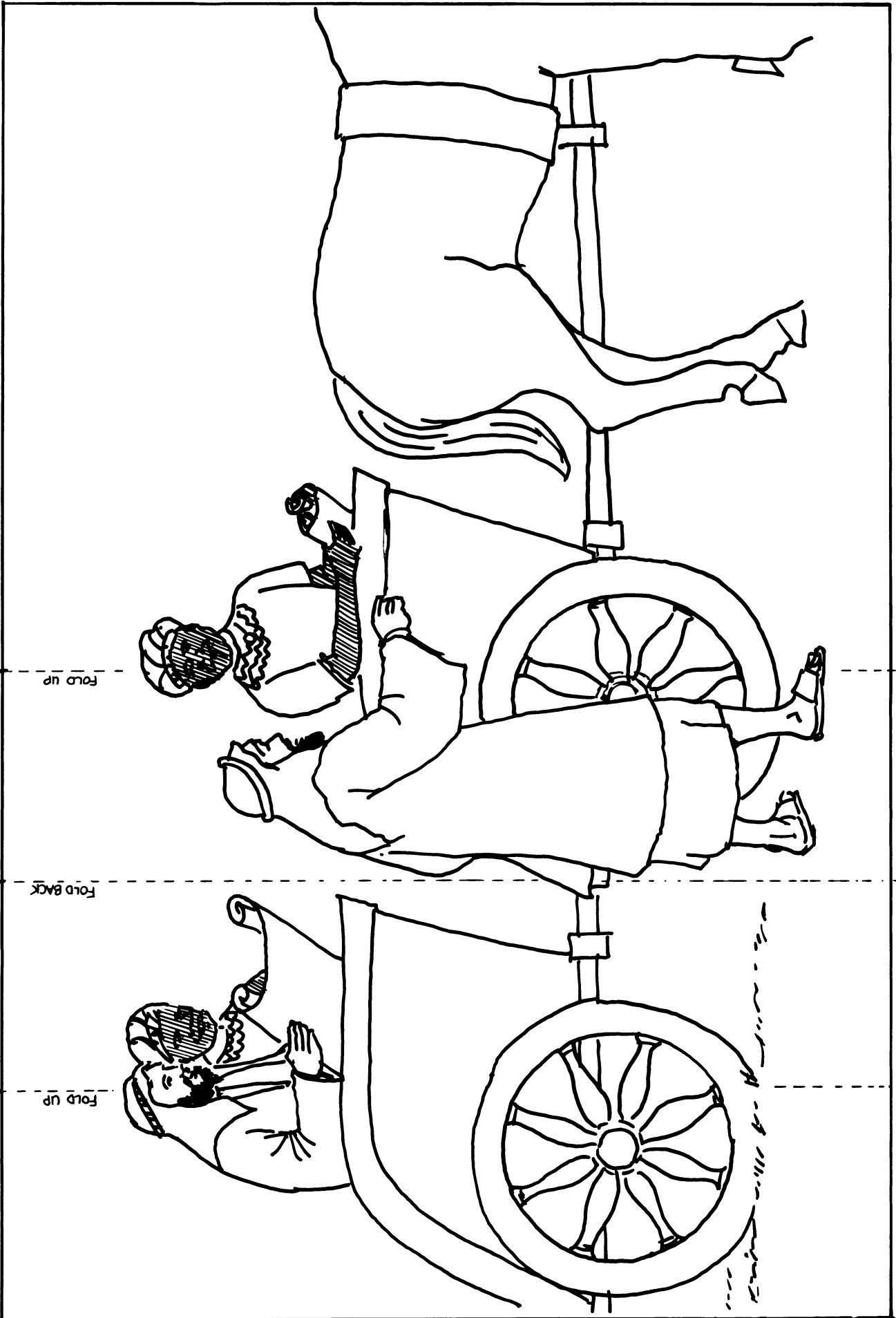
FOLD ALONG THE DOTTED LINES AS SHOWN, THEN

BEND THE FOLDED PART OVER

OR BACK TO ILLUSTRATE THE DIFFERENT PARTS OF THE STORY.

HOW TO MAKE IT.

COPY PICTURE BELOW ONTO CARD OR STIFF PAPER. MAKE SLIT IN THE CARD ON THE DOTTED LINE. COPY AND CUT OUT THE FIGURE ON PAGE 21 AND GUE ON A TAB (AS SHOWN OPPOSITE) ON THE REVERSE SIDE. SCHOLARS CAN COLOUR THE PICTURES TO FINISH THE MODEL OFF.
