

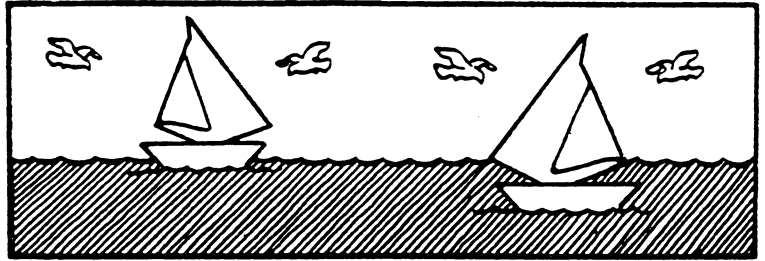

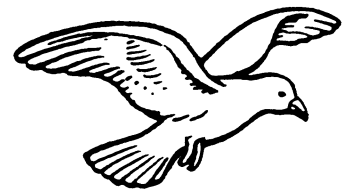
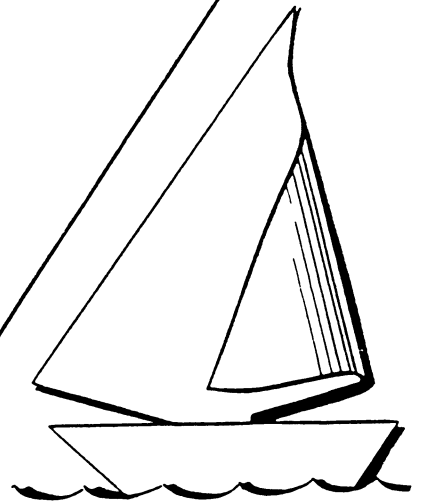

HOW TO MAKE IT.

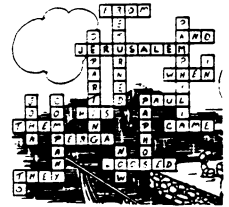
CUT BOATS FROM BRIGHT COLOURED PAPER AND SAILS FROM WHITE PAPER. TURN BACK THE CORNER OF EACH SAIL AND MATCH Xs AS SHOWN IN ILLUSTRATION. PASTE CORNER WITHOUT CREASING THE SAIL. ATTACH SAILS TO BOATS. CUT "WAVES" IN A STRIP OF DARK BLUE PAPER AND PASTE BOATS "IN" THE WAVES. SEE ILLUSTRATION. MOUNT BOATS AND WATER ON A BACKGROUND OF LIGHT BLUE PAPER. ADD SEAGULLS CUT FROM GREY PAPER.



PUZZLE 'MARK DEPARTED' ACTS 13:13

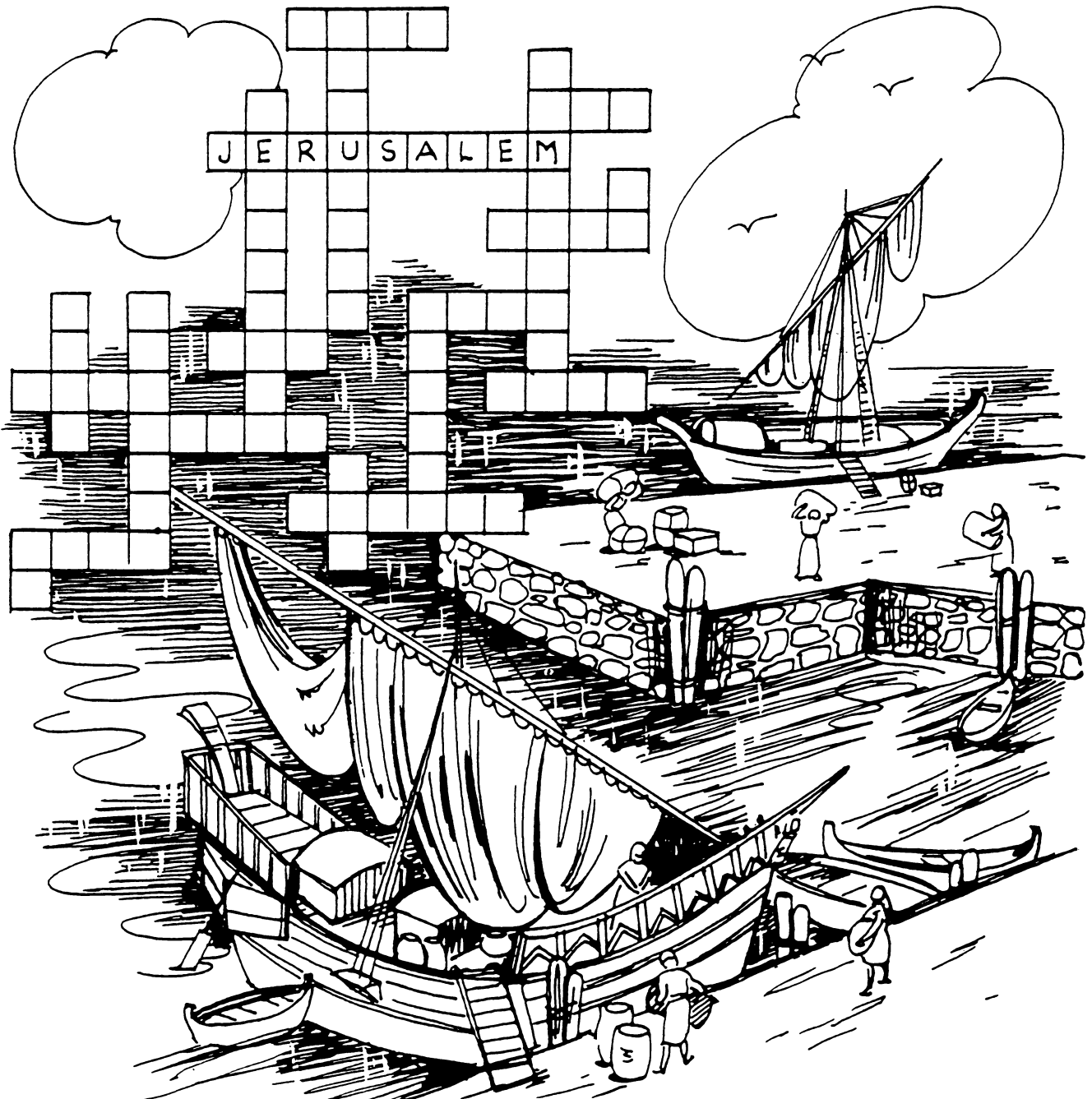
IN THIS PUZZLE, EVERY WORD IN THE PASSAGE IS USED (ACTS 13:13). EACH WORD IS USED ONLY ONCE NO MATTER HOW OFTEN IT APPEARS IN THE PASSAGE TO BEGIN THE PUZZLE, FILL IN THE LONGEST WORD THEN THE SECOND LONGEST, AND SO ON UNTIL THE PUZZLE IS COMPLETE.

ROCKING BOAT.

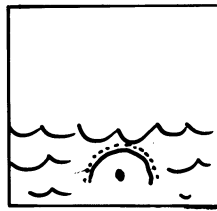
MATERIALS REQUIRED.

- CARDBOARD ● SCISSORS ● PAPER - FASTENER ● BLUE CELLOPHANE OR PAPER.

HOW TO MAKE IT.

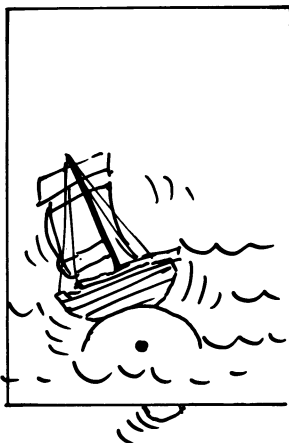
PHOTOCOPY OR COPY THE SHIP PROVIDED BELOW AND CUT OUT. ON ANOTHER PIECE OF PAPER STICK OR DRAW SEA. TO MAKE SEA USE SMALL SQUARES OF DIFFERENT COLOURED BLUE PAPER ; OR OVERLAY GREEN PAPER WITH A WHITE BACK. TEAR THE EDGES ON THE GREEN PAPER SIDWAYS SO THAT THE EDGES WILL FRAY THUS GIVING WHITE WAVES ON THE SEA.

PUNCH A HOLE APPROX. 50MM FROM THE BOTTOM OF THE PAPER IN THE CENTRE OF THE SEA. SLIT AN ARC APPROX 15MM ABOVE HOLE.



PUNCH A HOLE WHERE INDICATED ON SHIP. SLIP TAB OF SHIP THROUGH ARC ON WATER SCENE.

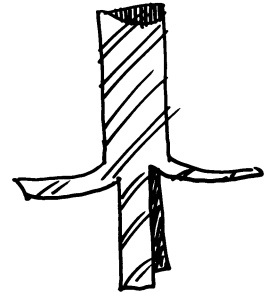
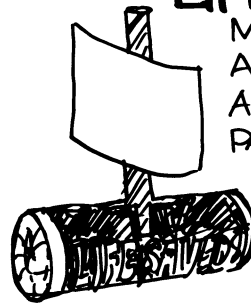
FASTEN BOAT AND SCENE TOGETHER BY INSERTING PAPER FASTENER THROUGH HOLES.



TAKE HOME TREAT.

LIFE SAVER BOAT.

MAKE A BOAT FROM A PACKET OF LIFE SAVERS, A STRAW AND PIECE OF PAPER FOR A SAIL.



CUT STRAW IN THIS MANNER AND GLUE TO PACKET OF LIFESAVERS. GLUE PAPER SAIL TO STRAW.
