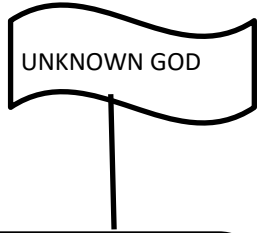


Paul in Athens
