

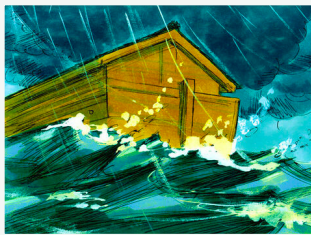
LESSON 4 CAIN & ABEL

LESSON 5 NOAH & THE FLOOD

It took a lot of faith for Noah to believe that what God said would actually happen! But the flood DID come, just as God had said – and so we can have faith like Noah that God has said Jesus will return to this earth and we can be sure that this too WILL actually happen! This week, read Hebrews 11v6-8 and talk with your family about what faith is, what the reward of faith is and how you can show faith in your life.



LESSON 6 THE CALL OF ABRAM

Abram listened to what God told him, he believed and he obeyed, and because of his belief and obedience, great promises were made to him. We can also be like Abram, by reading God's word, believing it to be true and obeying God by living a life that is pleasing to Him AND we can be part of the promise made to Abraham! This week, read Galatians 3v26-29 and discuss with your family how we can be a part of this promise.
