

LESSON 10 - JACOB & ESAU

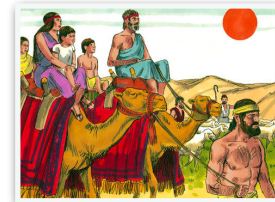

must always remember to tell the truth – lying is never going to be a better choice and is not how God wants us to behave. Talk about this with your family and look at Proverbs 12v22 “Lying lips are an abomination to the Lord, but those who deal truthfully are His delight”.

A good little reminder of this is to think of your shadow as your “unseen angel”!
